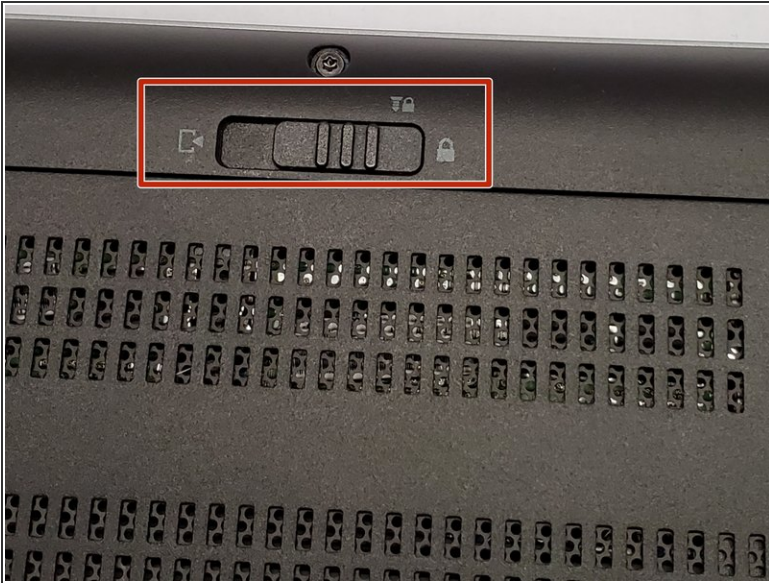

## Step 1 — Back Panel



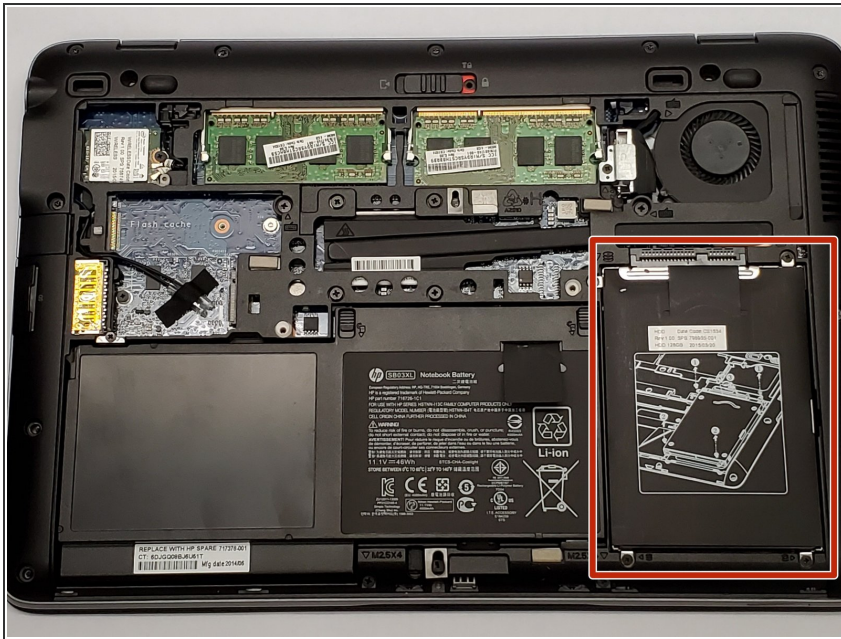
- Slide the lever firmly to the left on the back panel.
- i* Once the back panel is unlocked, there should be red showing to the right of the lever.

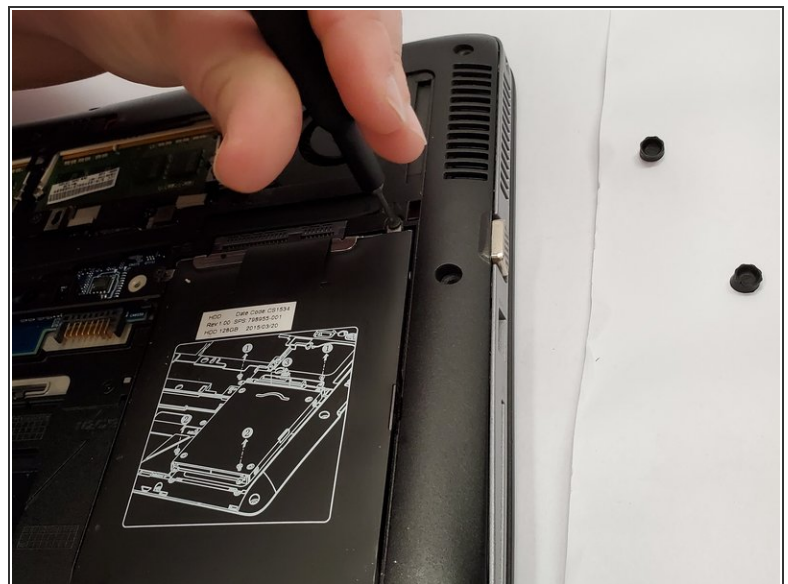
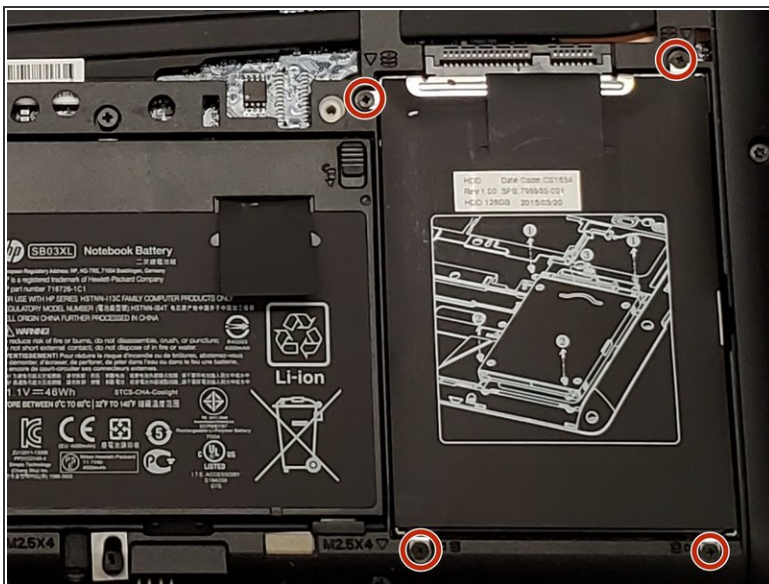
- Slide the back panel towards you.

- The hard drive is found on the bottom right under the back panel.

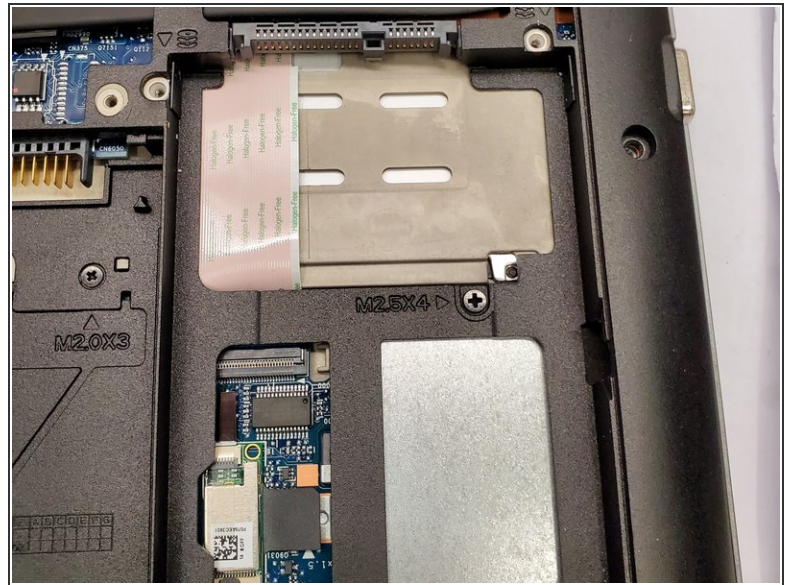
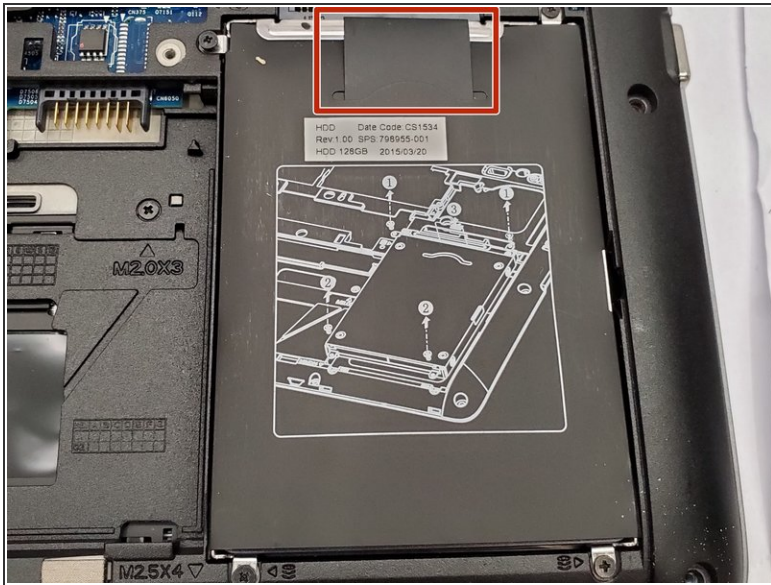
## Step 4



- Use a Phillips #0 screwdriver to unscrew the four 2 mm screws that secure the hard drive.



## Step 5



- Pull the tab at the top of the hard drive.
- Lift up and remove the hard drive.
