




HP Envy 700-030qe CPU Fan Replacement

INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you the process of replacing the CPU fan on the HP Envy 700-030qe desktop computer.

TOOLS:

- [Phillips #000 Screwdriver \(1\)](#)


Step 1 — CPU Fan



- Make sure that you are wearing your anti-static wristband. This will prevent damaging any internal parts with any built up static electricity.
- Unscrew the 10.5mm screw on the left of the desktop using your hand.


(i) If it is too tight you may use a torx-head screwdriver or a flat-head screwdriver.

Step 2




- Next, remove the side panel by sliding it towards the back of the desktop and pulling up, as shown.

Step 3




- Remove the four 120mm Phillips #000 head, 5 mm screws holding the fan.

Step 4



- Carefully pull up and disconnect the fan's power cable.

Step 5



- Remove the fan by pulling up carefully.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
