



HP Pavilion dv1000 Keyboard Replacement

INTRODUCTION

This guide will take you through the process of replacing a keyboard for a HP Pavilion dv1000.

TOOLS:

- **Phillips #0 Screwdriver** (1)
- **Spudger** (1)

Step 1 — Battery




- Shut down the computer.
- Disconnect all external devices and cables from the computer.

Step 2



- Flip the laptop over.

Step 3



- Locate the gray sliding tab next to the black bar where the battery is located.
- Slide the gray sliding tab to the left until you hear a distinct click.
- The inside edge of the battery should pop up.

Step 4



- Grasp the inside edge of the battery.
- Lift the inside edge of the battery up to detach the battery from the laptop.

Step 5 — Keyboard



- Remove the highlighted screws.
- After removing the screws, flip the laptop over.

Step 6



- Open the laptop.
- Use the spudger to lift the keyboard.

⚠ Do not pull the keyboard up and away from the computer, because it is still attached by a ribbon cable.

- Press the two white clips forward with your fingers and gently pull the ribbon from the clips.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
