
 **TOOLS:**

- Fingers (2)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

 **PARTS:**

- 2.5" SATA Hard Drive (1)

Step 1 — Hard drive




- Unplug the charger and remove the battery.

Step 2



- Flip over the laptop.

Step 3



- Remove the Hard Drive cover screws with a Phillips #1 screwdriver.


(i) The screws will not come all the way out

Step 4



- Remove the Hard Drive cover.

Step 5




- Remove the SATA cable from the hard drive, then remove the hard drive.

Step 6



- Remove the screws from the hard drive enclosure.

Step 7




- Remove the Hard Drive from the enclosure

Step 8



- Insert the new hard drive in enclosure.

Step 9



- Install an OS on the hard drive.

i For this system, Windows is recommended.

! Do not install a version of Windows that is not supported if this system is going to be connected to the internet, use a supported version, such as 8.1 or 10.
