INTRODUCTION

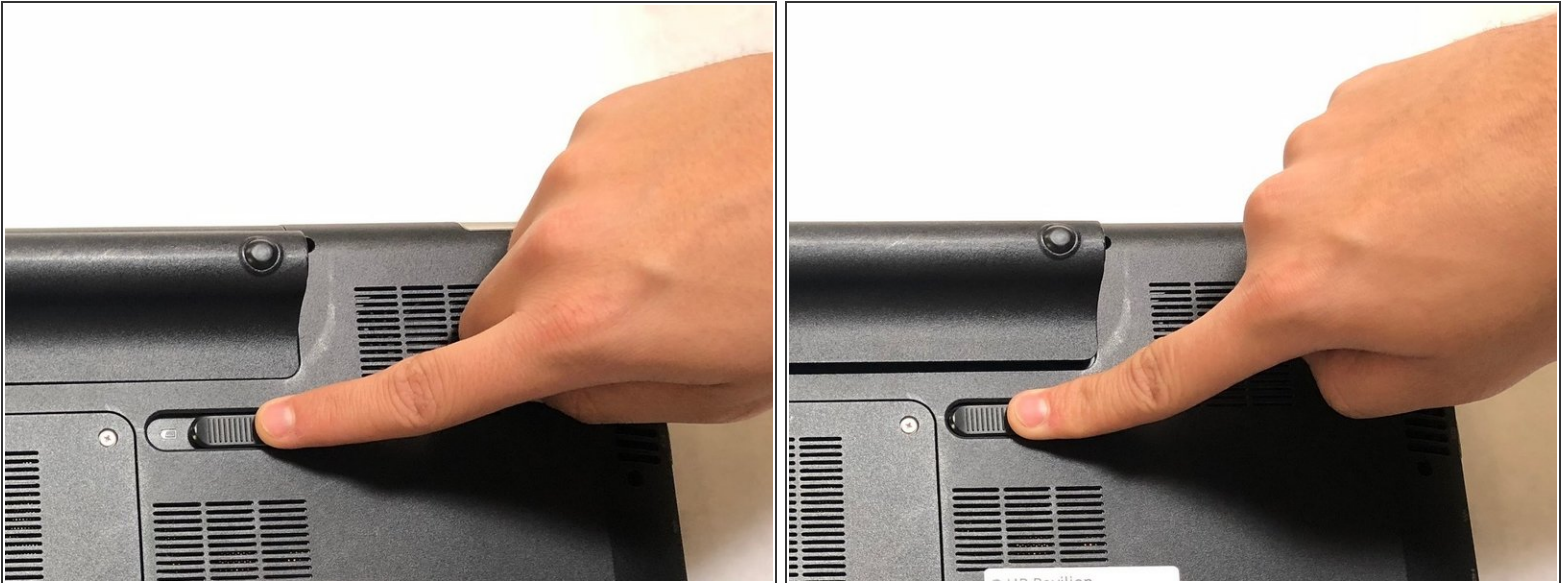
This guide will describe how to replace the hard drive of the HP Pavilion dv7-4285dx

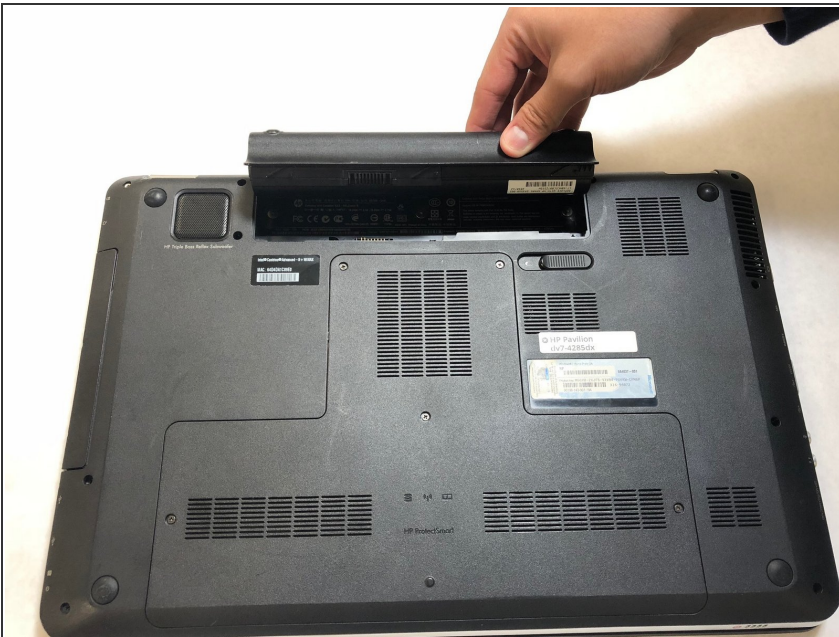
- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)
 - [Metal Spudger](#) (1)

Step 1 — Battery



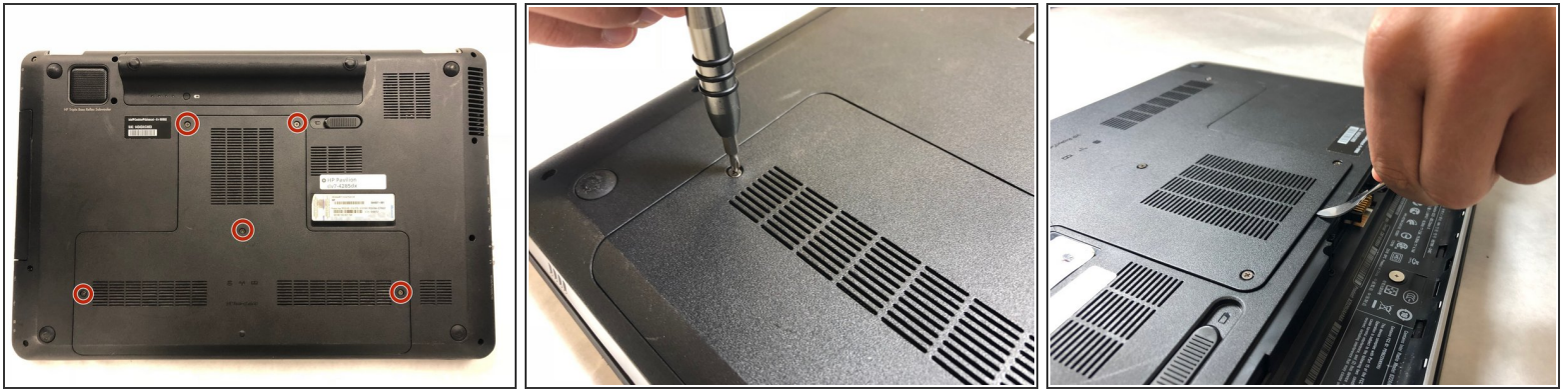
- Slide the battery release switch to the left. The battery pack will then subsequently release.

Step 2



- Remove the battery pack from the socket.

Step 3 — Hard Drive



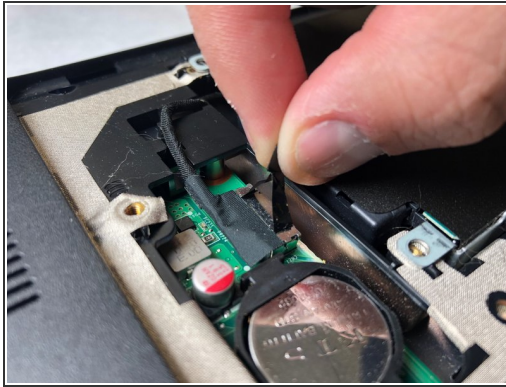
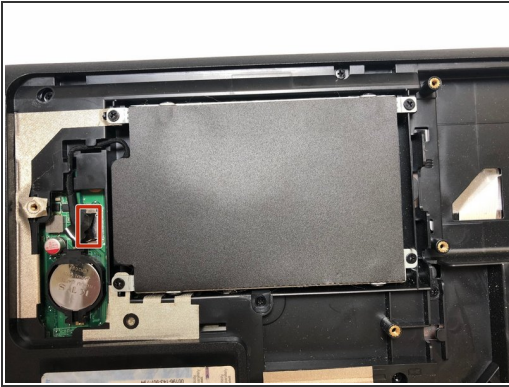
- Unscrew the 5 back plate screws using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.
- i* During the removal process, the back plate will retain the 5 back plate screws.
- Remove back plate using a metal spudger.

Step 4



- Remove the four 5.7 mm screws, holding down the hard drive, using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.

Step 5



- Pull up carefully on tab hooking the hard drive to the mother board.
- Remove the hard drive.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
