



HP Pavilion g7-1368dx Hard Drive Replacement

INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you how to replace the HP Pavilion g7-1368 hard drive. This process should take approximately 10 minutes using only a Phillips #1 screwdriver. Make sure to shut down the device before proceeding with the replacement.

TOOLS:

- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- Turn the device over so that the lower case is facing up.
- Slide the battery release latch. The battery will pop up.

Step 2



- Lift and remove the battery from its compartment.

Step 3 — Hard Drive




- Loosen the two Phillips #1 screws that connect the service panel to the device.
 - i* These are captive screws and cannot be fully removed. They will remain attached to the service panel.

Step 4



- Slide the service panel down and pull it up to remove.

Step 5



- Locate the hard drive.
- *(i)* It is missing from the device pictured here.
- Disconnect the cable connector by pulling it away from the hard drive.
- Remove the hard drive from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
