




HTC One Mini Teardown


- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)

- [Spudger](#) (1)

Step 1 — HTC One Mini Teardown



- Tools needed
 - Philips #00
 - Torx #5
 - Tweezers
 - Spudger
 - A strong drink
 - White russian
 - Vodka, Kalua, cream. Mix in equal parts and stir.

Step 2



- The guts of a HTC One mini, for your consideration.
- This looks important.
- There is nothing in this phone that can be repaired. Repairability score = 0/10.

Step 3



- Okay, since my joke teardown actually got approved by the friendly iFixit staff, I think I have to be serious for just a moment.
- The HTC One Mini is a glued and latched together mess of parts and wires.
- Replacing any component in the phone requires a near complete disassembly of the device.
- My job is repairing phones and tablets, and HTC is consistently the most frustrating brand to work with.
- I'm not saying it's impossible to repair it, but it is extremely difficult, and even if you are highly skilled you are very likely to irreversibly damage one or more or all of the components.
- I created this guide out of frustration, and to serve as a warning to others. If you have even a shred of doubt about your ability to repair this device, just forget about it.
- Yes, that's a hammer in the left side of the first picture.
