Step 1 — HUAWEI HONOR 5X Disassembly



- Turn off your cell phone before disassembling.

Step 2



- Remove the two 1.17mm Torx T3 screws from the bottom of the phone.

Step 3



- Use the Sim card ejection tool to remove both the sim card trays.

Step 4



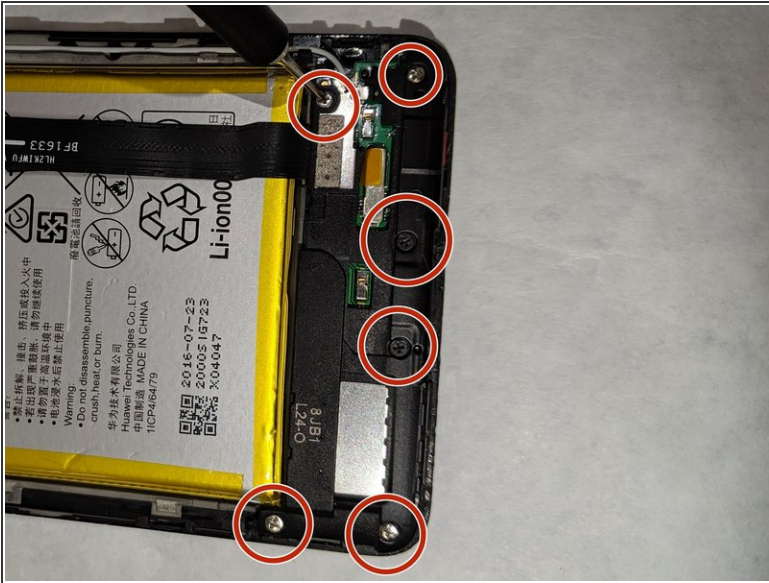
- To prepare the iOpener insert it in the microwave for 30 seconds and apply it on the side edges of the phone so that the glue underneath will soften.

Step 5



- Pry off the back with a plastic opening tool.

Step 6 — Speaker



- Remove the six Phillips #000 screws holding the speaker to the device.
- Remove the speaker

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
