This guide will show how to remove the back plastic cover from the Hasee Z7M-i78172D1 as well as the Graphic card fan.

Step 1 — Rear Panel



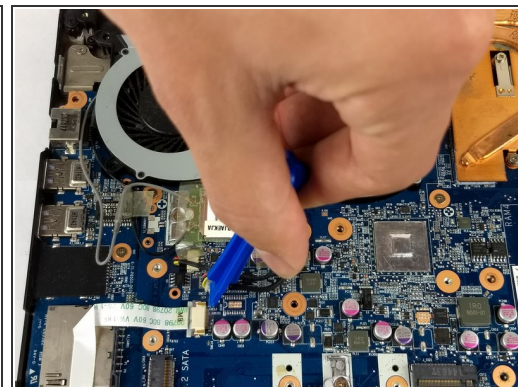
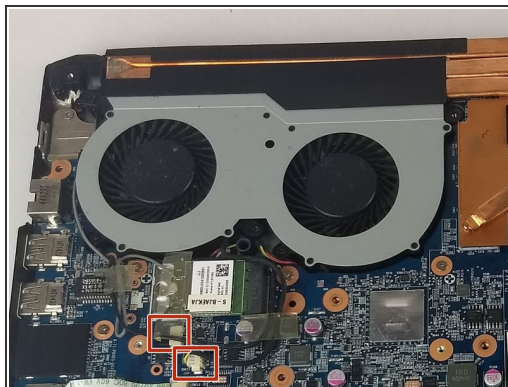
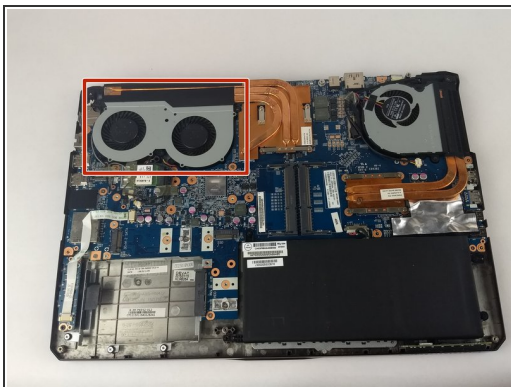
- Use a #0 Phillips head screwdriver and unscrew the sixteen 7mm screws on the back of the device.

Step 2



- Use a plastic opening tool to take off the back plastic panel.

Step 3 — Graphic Card Fan



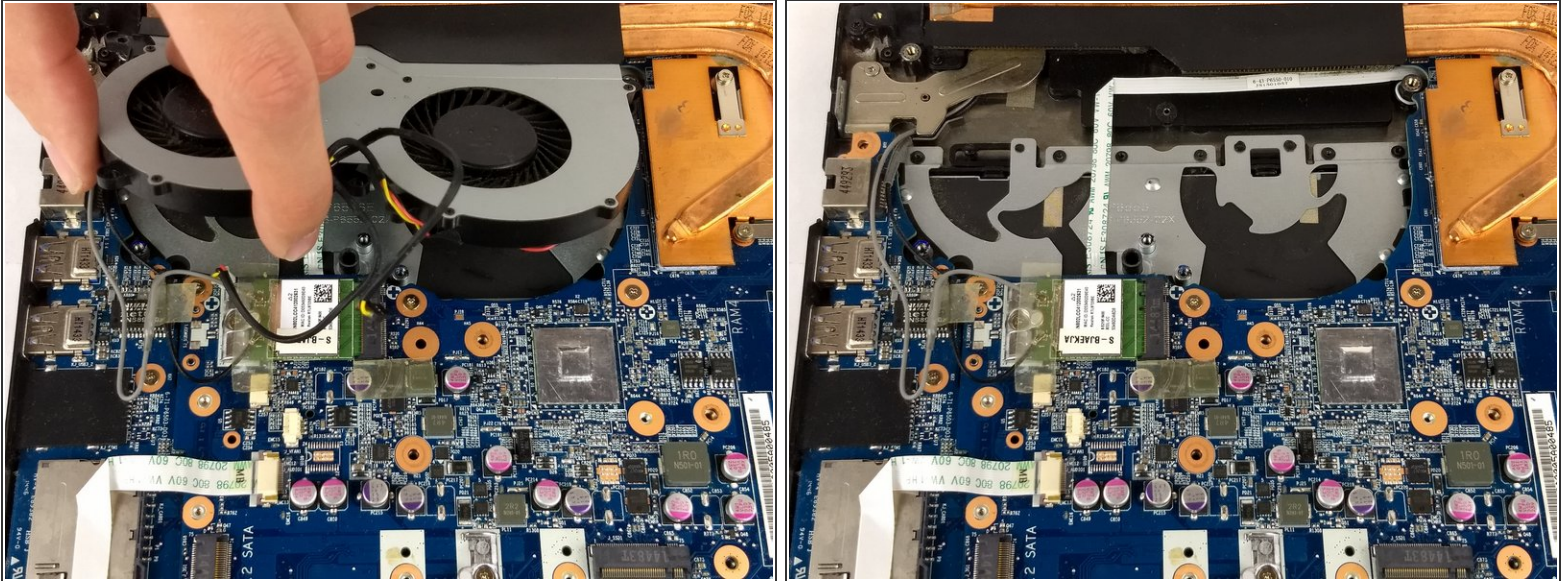
- To take out the Graphics card fan it is necessary to disconnect the two Graphic card fan cables. Use a plastic opening tool to remove the cable.

Step 4



- Use a #0 Phillips head screwdriver and unscrew the five 7mm screws holding the fan in place.

Step 5



- Lift the Graphics card fan out and replace with the replacement fan.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
