INTRODUCTION

Every Honda antenna is a little different, and they all seem to present their own challenges. This video will cover just about every contingency when repairing one of these units.

It may be best to go for a cheap whip antenna replacement as it can save you a lot of time and headache. If you have your heart set on a working power antenna in your Honda, this video should help.

- You only need to go to minute 8 if you are directly swapping out the antenna. Watch the whole video if you are attempting to repair.

- Large Needle Nose Pliers (1)
- Antenna Socket (1)
- 19 mm Box End Wrench (1)
- 3/8" Drive Ratchet (1)
- 10mm Socket (1)
- Penetrating Lubricant (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- Flathead Screwdriver (1)
- White Lithium Grease (1)
- Hammer (1)

PARTS:

- Power Antenna (1)
