




How to Clean Intake Manifold 2009-2015 Toyota Prius

INTRODUCTION

You want to do this service every 100-120k miles due to oil and sludge getting trap in the intake manifold, and also preventative maintenance on the PCV valve. Its best to do this service so you can kill 2 birds with 1 stone.

Torque specs:

- 21 ft. lbs - Intake manifold bolts and nuts
- 6 ft. lbs - MAP sensor
- 7 ft. lbs - EGR pipe bolts
- 15 ft. lbs - Oil dipstick guide sub assembly bolts
- 7 ft. lbs - Throttle body bolts

- 3/8-Inch Drive Extension Bar (1)
- 10mm Deep Socket (1)
- 10mm Wrench (1)

- Hose Clamp (1)
- Pick Tool (1)
- Aerosol Brake Cleaner (1)
- Torque Wrench (1)

PARTS:

- Intake Gasket (1)

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
