INTRODUCTION


I have many 64 GB Kingston DataTraveler SE9 G2 3.0 USB Flash Drives and occasionally one will not eject after use, even when all applications are quit. Rather than go thru elaborate other methods, here's a simple solution.

Step 1 — Force eject Kingston USB flash drive on Mac



- Open Activity Monitor. Find QuickLookUIService in the Memory column.

Step 2 — Kill QuickLookUIService



- Tap the x box in upper Left corner of window to quit this process. (You may have to choose Force Quit). Once QuickLookUIService is quit, Eject will work instantly.
