



Huawei P10 Back Cover Replacement

This guide shows how to replace the back cover of your Huawei P10.

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INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to replace the back cover of your Huawei P10 smartphone.

Step 1 — Back Cover




- Switch off your phone.
- Remove the two Pentalobe P2 screws at the bottom.
- Remove the SIM card tray.

Step 2



- Insert a plastic opening tool between the display and the case starting at the bottom area of your phone.
- Carefully pry the display with its parts out of the case.
- *(i)* Getting the prying tool in will require some effort, be careful not to slide the tool too much or you might slightly damage the housing.
- After you pried out the bottom end, use the opening tool to open the clamps on both sides.

Step 3



⚠ Don't open the phone all the way, yet. The cable for the standby and volume buttons is still connected to the back cover.

- Swing open the phone backwards.
- Use a spudger to disconnect the power- and volume button flex cable.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
