




JD Razor 2000 Front Wheel Replacement

Replacing the front wheel.

INTRODUCTION

The front wheel of the JD Razor 2000 is located directly underneath the handlebar and T-Bar.


TOOLS:

- Lubricant (1)
- Macro Bit Set (1)

PARTS:

- 98 mm Scooter Wheel (1)

Step 1 — Removing the 1.75" Axle Bolt



- Orient the scooter so that the front wheel is facing you. Observe the right and left side of the wheel. Remember which is which throughout the guide.
- Using an Allen wrench, unscrew the axle bolt slowly from the right side while applying a constant pressure with your hand on the left side of the bearing.
 - *i* If the left side of the bolt turns while you unscrew the right side, you will need to use a second Allen wrench to prevent it from moving
 - *i* If the bolt does not move at all, or moves very little, try applying a lubricant on as much of the screw as possible and try again in 5 minutes.
- Carefully pull apart the bolt and bearing from either side of the wheel.

Step 2 — Removing the Wheel



- Grip the bottom of the wheel and gently slide it out.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
