These steps will walk you through how to replace the water gasket on the Keurig B60.

INTRODUCTION

Replacing the Water Filter requires only a couple steps as outlined below.

TOOLS:


- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Water Filter




- Remove the Water Reservoir Cap and the Water Reservoir from the brewer by simply pulling up and out

Step 2



- Remove the three 9.5 mm Phillips #1 screws that secure the small circular screen to the bottom of the water reservoir.

Step 3



- This circular screen has a rubber "O"-ring around the base. Use the plastic opening tool to pry off the rubber seal. Replace with undamaged seal.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
