



# Kodak Easyshare V1003 LCD Display Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

This guide provides step-by-step instructions for removing and replacing the LCD display. There are two tools required and no safety precautions needed.

## Step 1 — Battery



- Turn off camera by firmly pressing the power button that is located on the top of the camera.

## Step 2



- Position camera with the bottom facing up.



## Step 3



- With your finger, slide the battery cover in the direction of the open arrow.

## Step 4



- Lift the battery cover up gently.

## Step 5



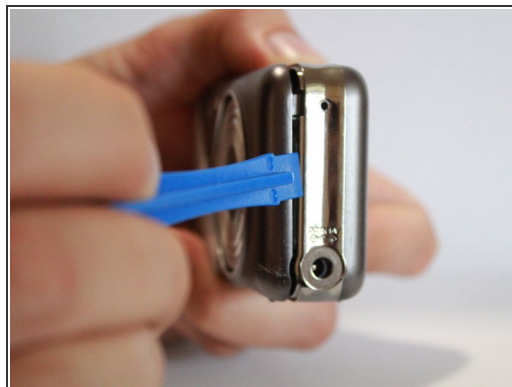
- Gently push the battery down until a click is heard. Battery should release and be lifted out of slot.

## Step 6 — Buttons



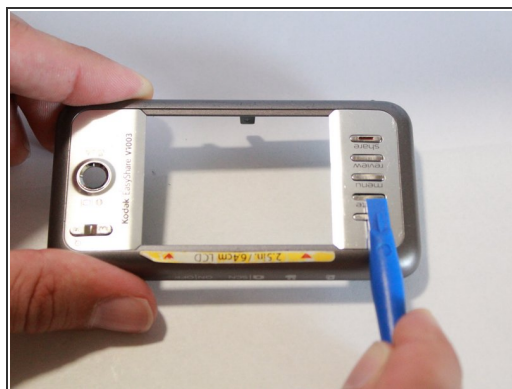
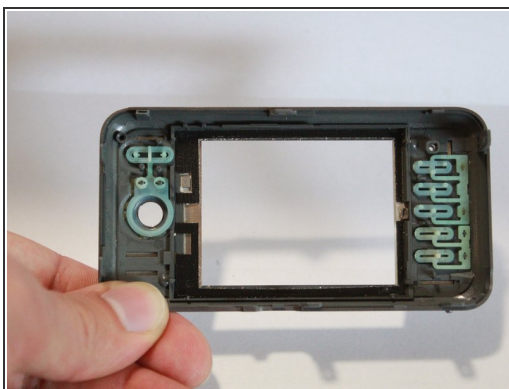
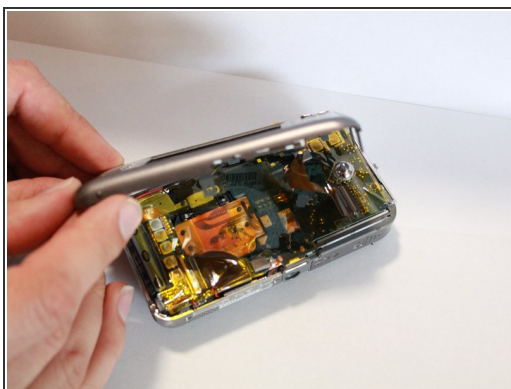
- Use a J00 screwdriver to remove the five exterior screws.

## Step 7



- Use a plastic opening tool to pry off the back casing.

## Step 8



- Completely remove the back casing from the device.
- Using a plastic tool to remove the bottom.

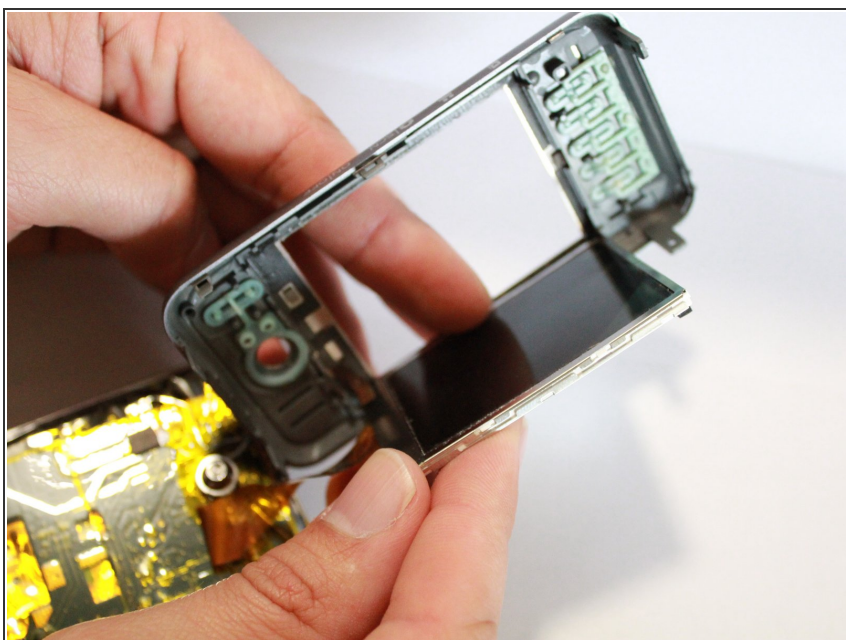


## Step 9 — LCD Display



- Remove the LCD display by unplugging the connector.

## Step 10



- Take apart the LCD display from the back case.
