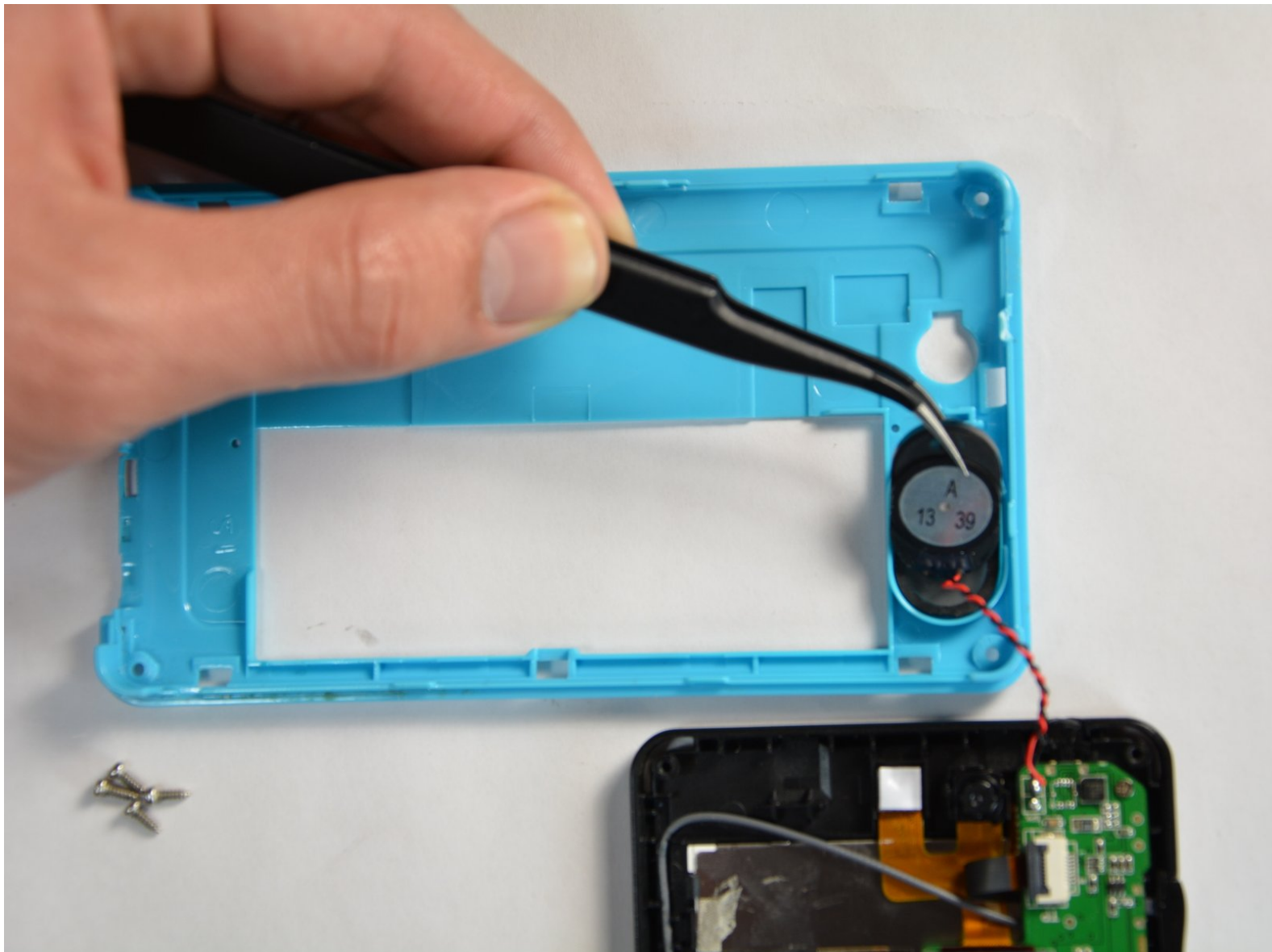




Kurio Touch 4S Speaker Replacement

This guide will show you how to replace the speakers in your Kurio Touch 4S.

Step 1 — Speakers



- Make sure to open the back cover easily using the plastic opening tool.

Step 2



- Remove back cover by prying away from the device.
- ⓘ The easiest place to remove the cover is from the bottom and top; try to open it from the right and left sides.
- ⚠ Open it gently. Do not open it with too much pressure, so that the plastic back cover do not break.

Step 3



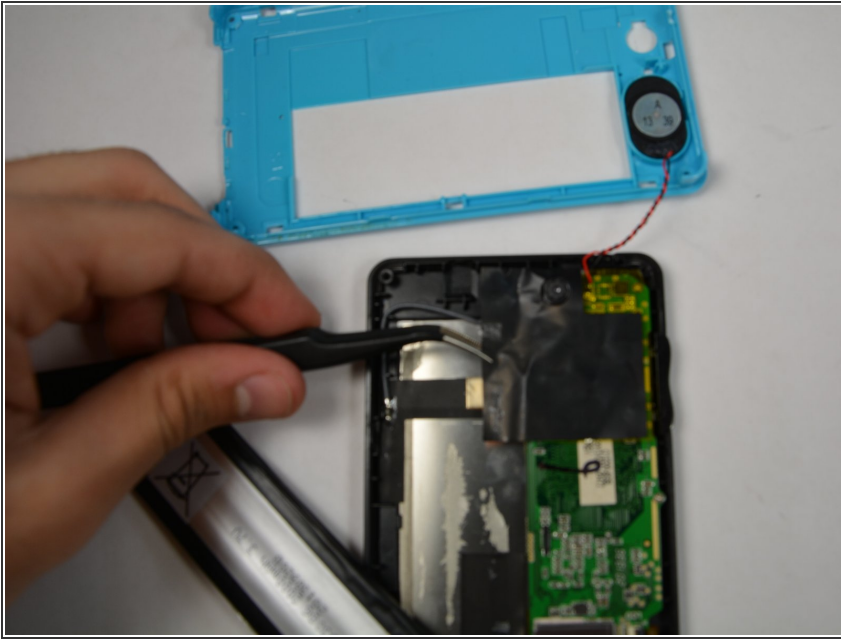
- To remove the battery, make sure the four 5mm Philips screws on each side of your device is open using the Phillips #1 Screwdriver
- After you remove your four 5mm Philips screws, use your plastic opening tool to help you open the plastic cover of your device.

Step 4



- After you remove your four 5mm Philips screws, use your plastic opening tool to help you open the plastic cover of your device.

Step 5



- Gently remove the plastic cover that is covering the camera.

Step 6



- Separate the two halves of your Kurio Touch 4S and lay them besides each other.

Step 7



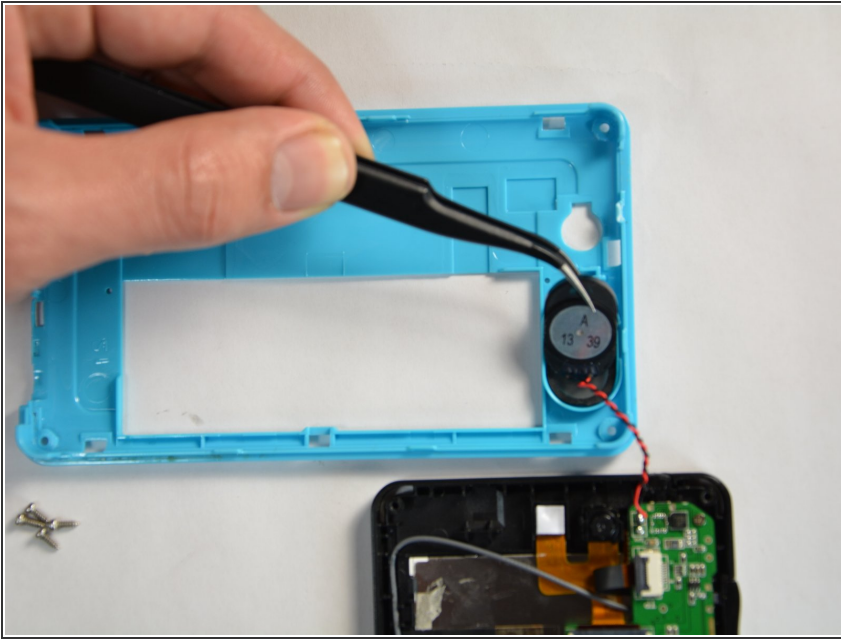
- Use the soldering tool to detach the speaker wires.

Step 8



- Press the speaker in the manner shown so that it comes out of its slot.
- ⚠ Be sure not to apply too much force or you can break the back cover.

Step 9



- Use the Tweezers to remove the speaker from its place.

⚠ Remove the speaker gently.
