INTRODUCTION

Removing the rear casing is simple and easy with the right tools and a little effort. This is also the initial process to access the phone's internal circuitry.

TOOLS:

Step 1 — Rear Case



- Wedge the opening device into the side crease of the phone.

Step 2



- Slide the opening device downward to dis-join the rear casing from the front casing. Continue around all edges.

Step 3



- Remove the back casing from the front casing. Force may be necessary.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
