Before being able to do anything inside your LG G Pad, you will need to remove the back panel. Follow this guide to do so.

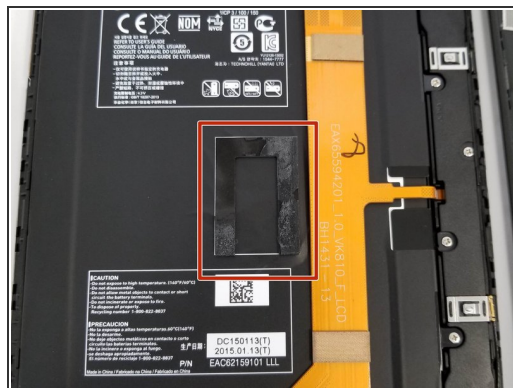
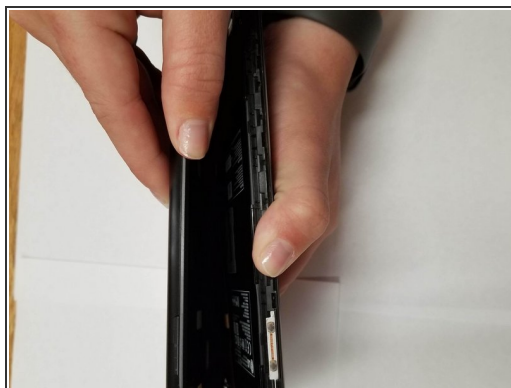

-  If the panel does not budge, be aware that there is adhesive on the back of the battery holding the back shut. Make sure to just move around the perimeter of the back panel until the panel is able to lift forward.
