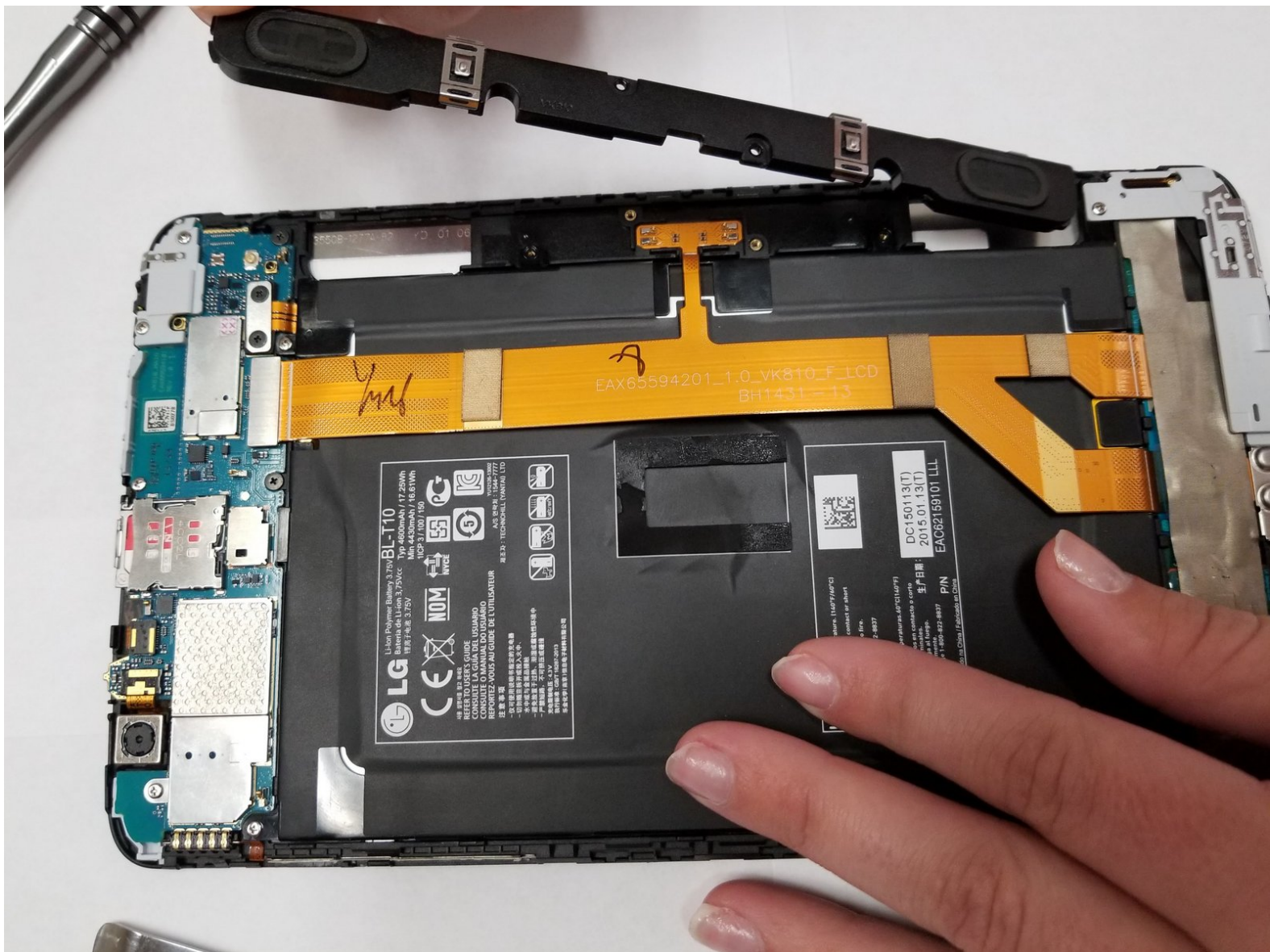




# LG G Pad 8.3 4G Speakers Replacement

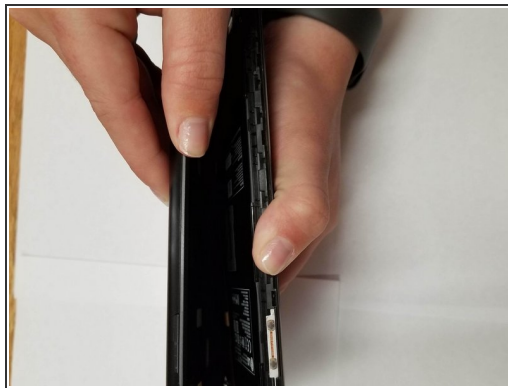



## TOOLS:

-  Be gentle when popping the panel off.



-  If the panel does not budge, be aware that there is adhesive on the back of the battery holding the back shut. Make sure to just move around the perimeter of the back panel until the panel is able to lift forward.

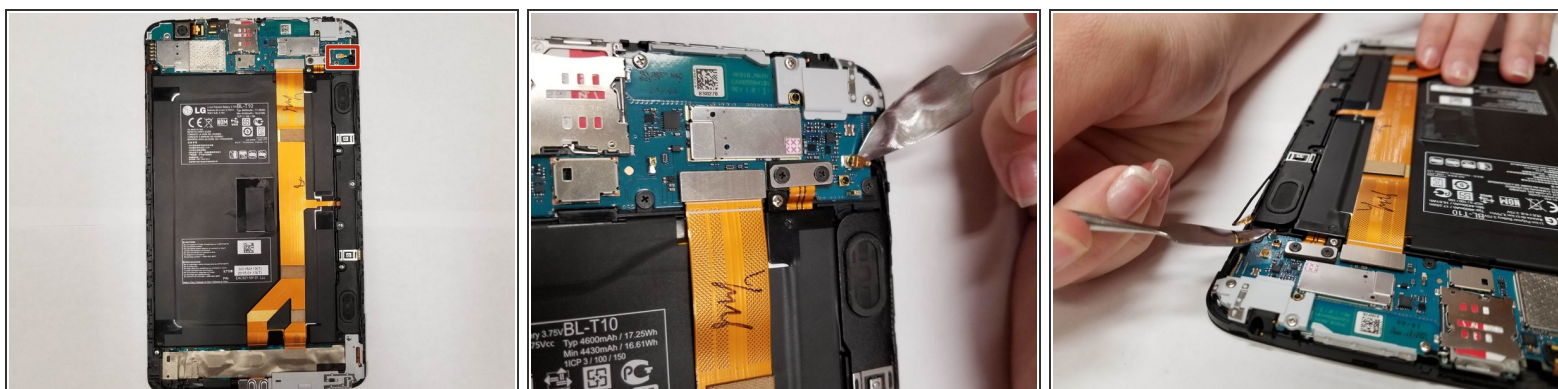


## Step 3 — Speakers



- Remove the 4 1.5 mm screws holding the speakers in place.

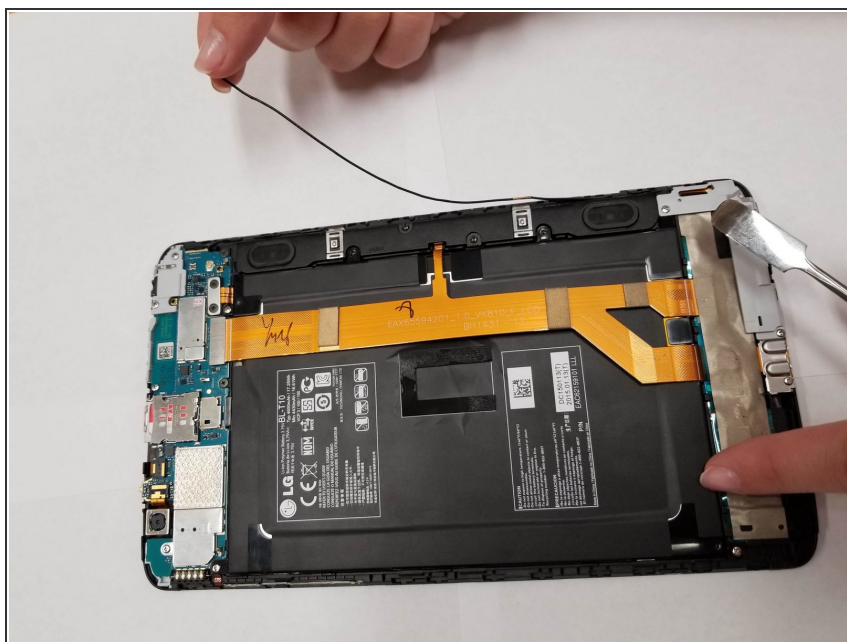
## Step 4



- Put the spudger underneath the gold cap of the cable and lift to disconnect from device.

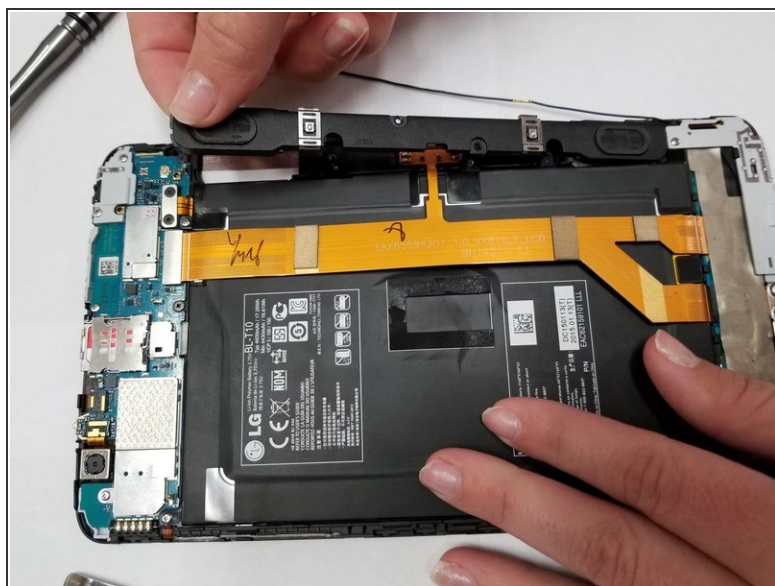
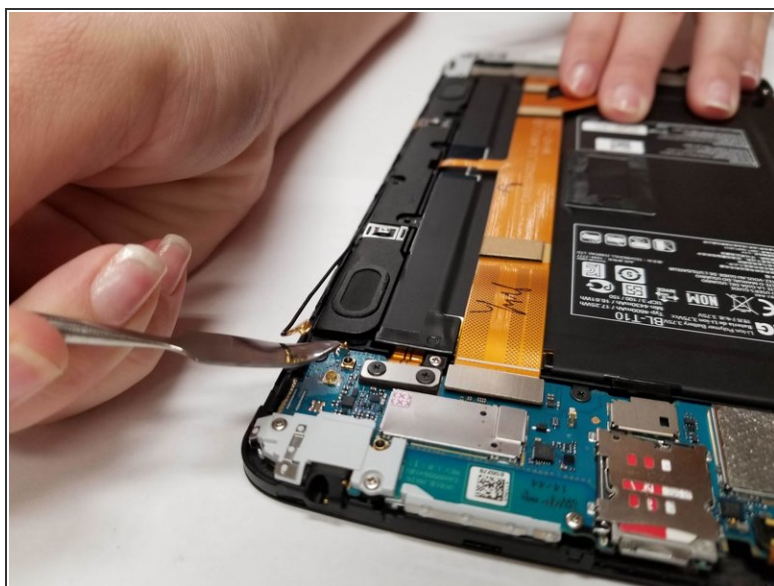
⚠ This cable can be damaged easily.

## Step 5



- Pull the cable back and out of the way of the speaker.

## Step 6



- Place the spudger in between the speaker and the device to pop the speaker out of place.
- Pull the speaker out of the device.
