



# LG G Pad X 8.0 Battery Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

A battery replacement is actually quite simple to do for this tablet requiring minimum time and a few handy tools. You'll soon be able to go from no battery life to hours with this easy guide.



## Step 1 — Removing Backplate



- Power off the device before starting battery replacement.
- Remove SD card and SIM Card.
- With the opening tool, gently pry the back plate away from the main board. The corners are the easiest spots to start at.


## Step 2 — Peeling Back Cover Off



- Gently pull the back cover away from the adhesive on the battery.


**⚠** It may be possible to use a blow dryer on low heat but I'd advise against it unless absolutely necessary.

## Step 3 — Detaching Old Battery



- Slowly and gently lift the power cable upwards.
- Unscrew the 4 screws keeping the battery in place, set aside.

## Step 4 — Removing the Battery



- Remove the battery by pulling up gently.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
