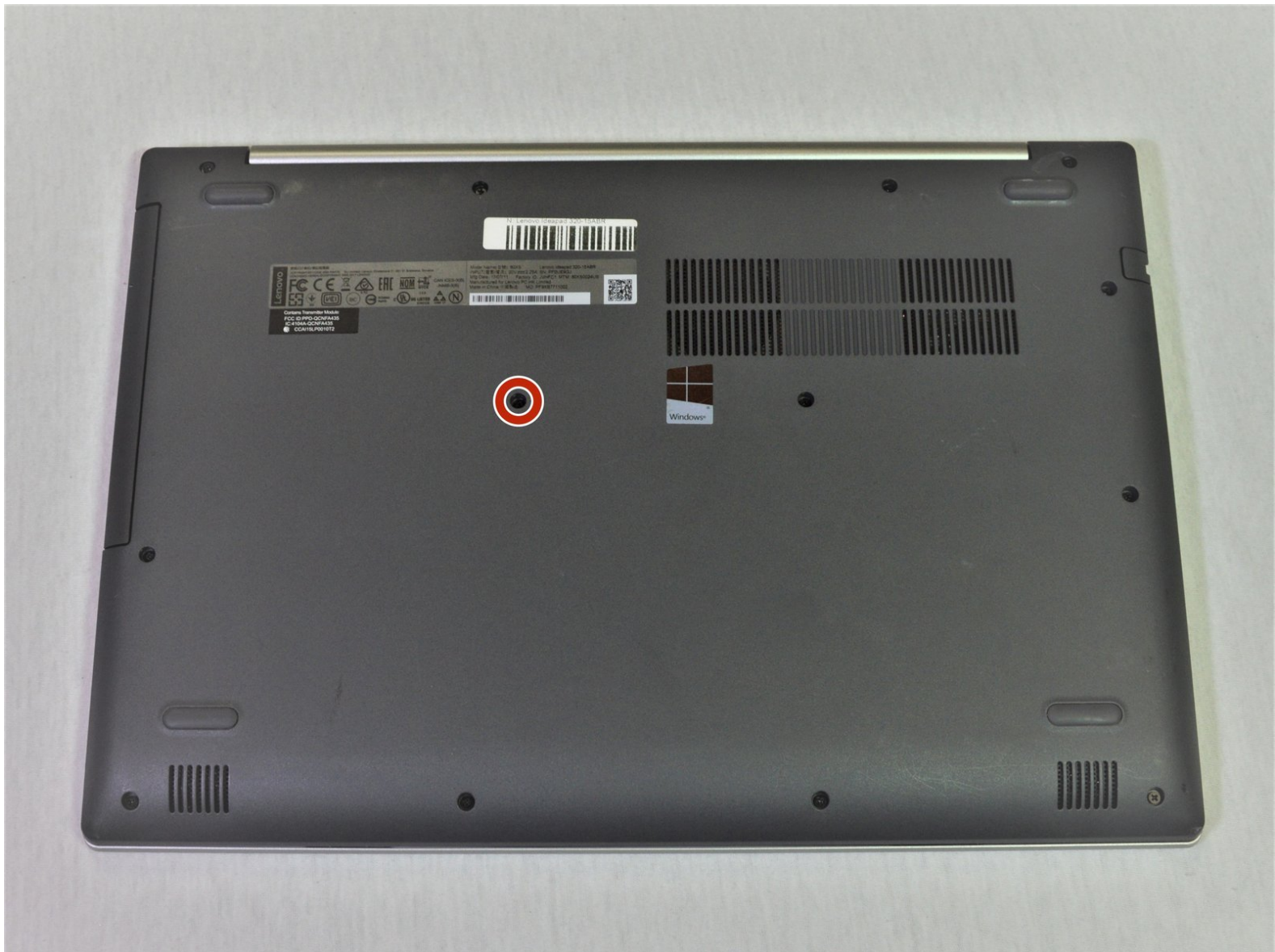




Lenovo Ideapad 320-15ABR Back Panel Replacement

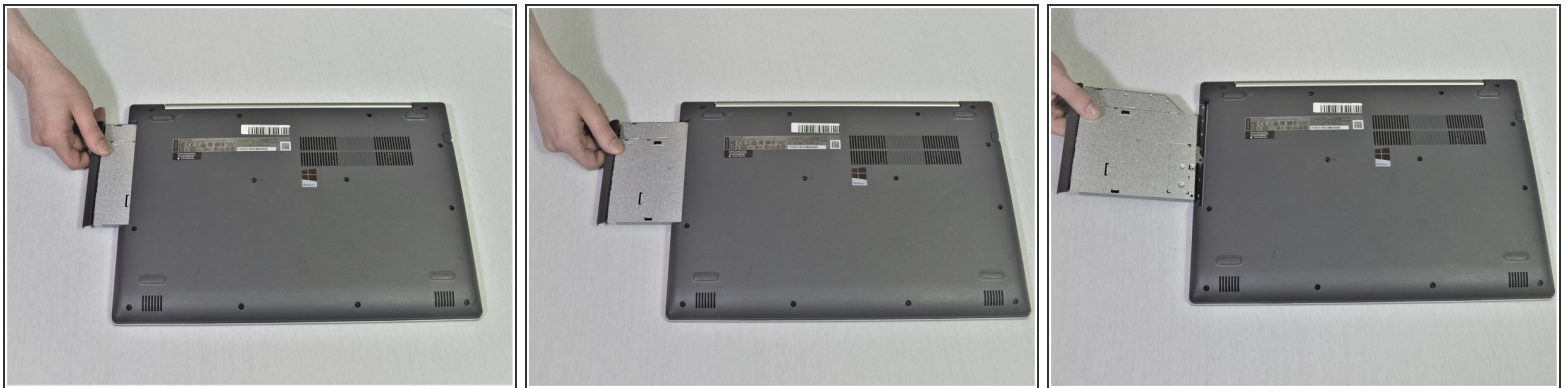
- [Phillips #1 Screwdriver](#) (1)

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Step 1 — Back Panel



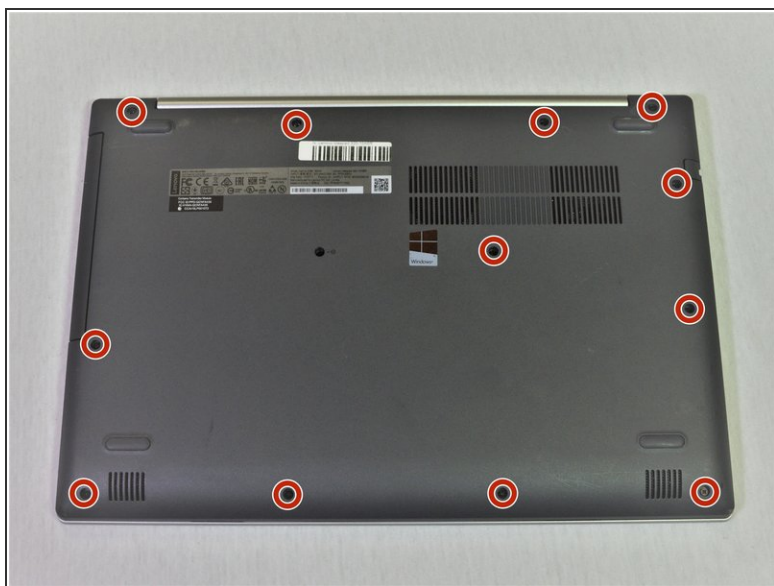
-  Before you proceed, make sure your computer is turned off and is not connected to any power source.
-  Remove the single 7 mm Phillips #1 screw securing the optical drive.
-  Be sure to store the screws carefully as they are easy to lose. A magnetic project mat is recommended

Step 2



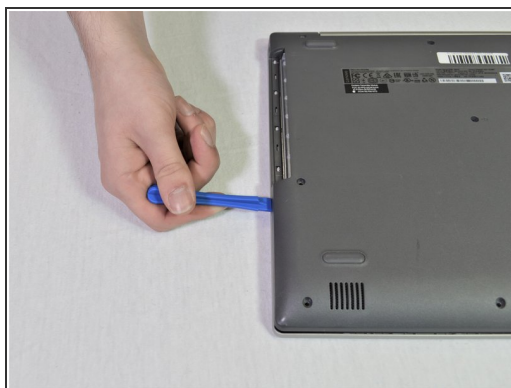
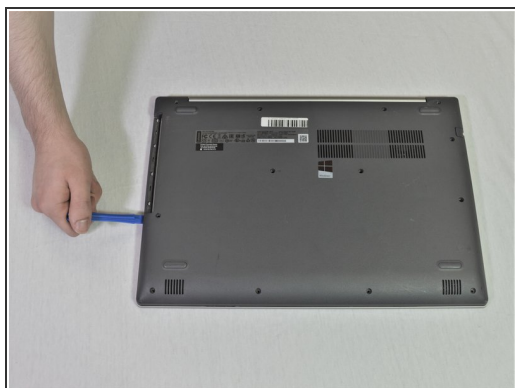
-  Carefully remove the optical drive bracket by pulling the bezel away from the laptop.

Step 3



- Using the Phillips #1 screwdriver, remove the twelve screws around the back panel from the laptop.

Step 4



- Use an opening tool to pry out the back cover.

Step 5



- Remove the back panel by pulling it up and away from the laptop.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
