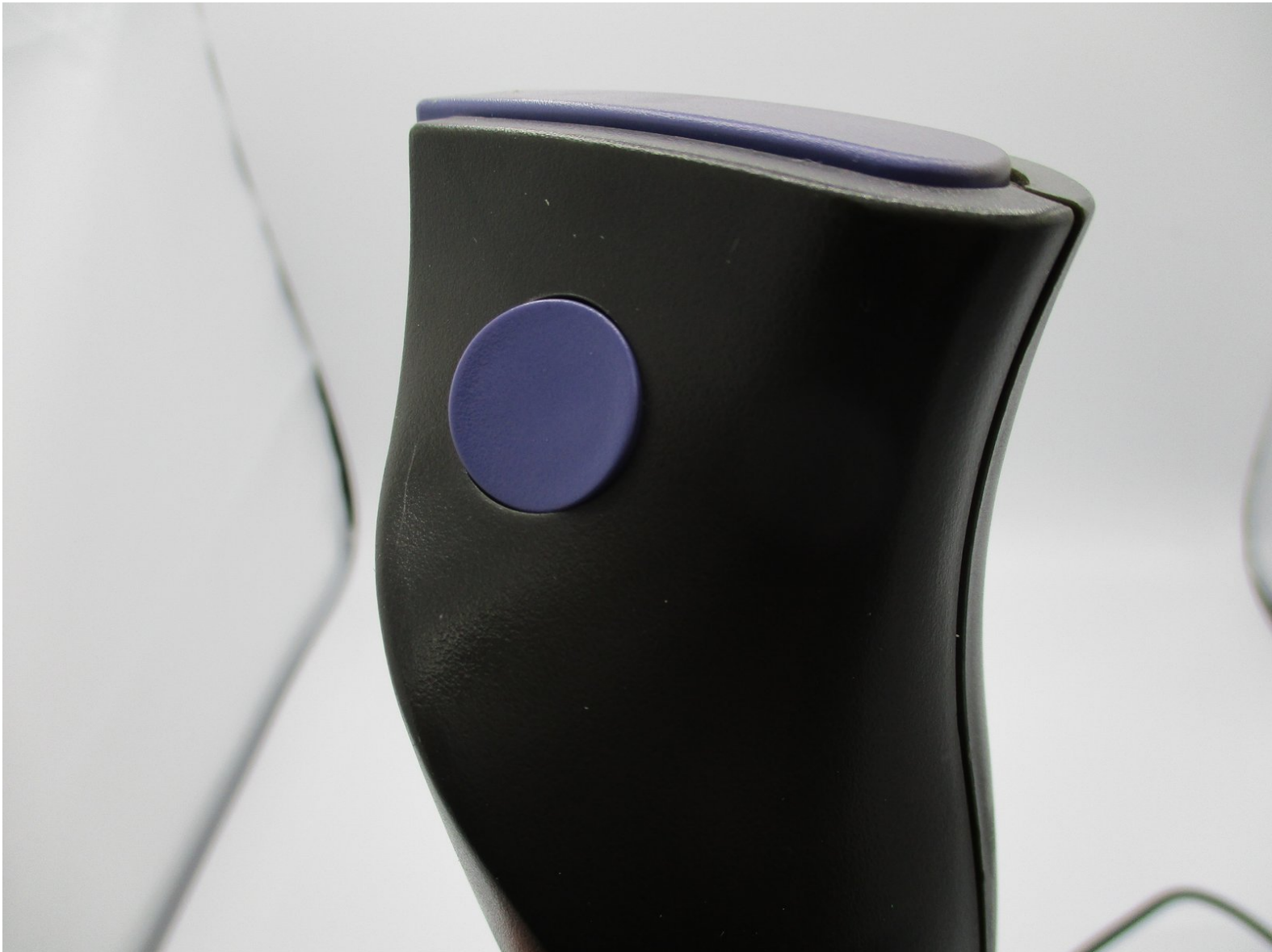




# Logitech Dexxa Joystick Secondary Button Cap Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

The secondary button is an important part of your controller. Your secondary button may become sticky, stuck or damaged over time. This part can be easily replaced and cleaned.

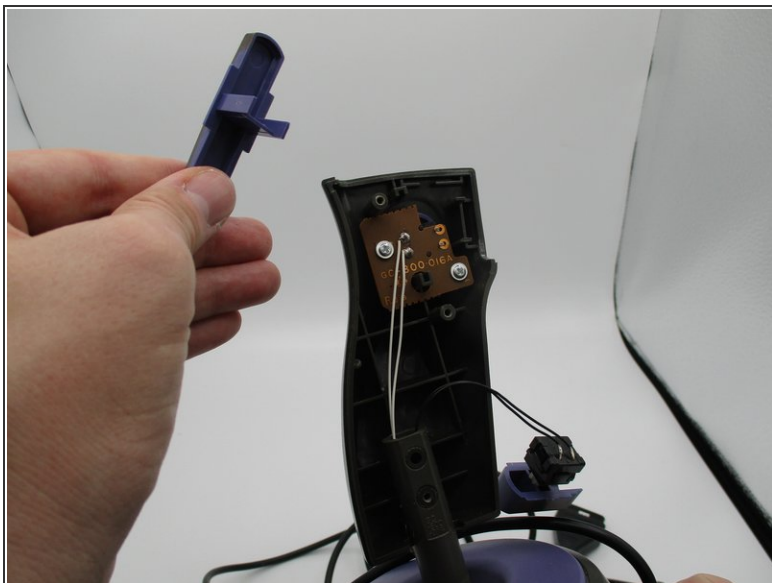
## Step 1 — Trigger Cap



 Unplug your Joystick before use.

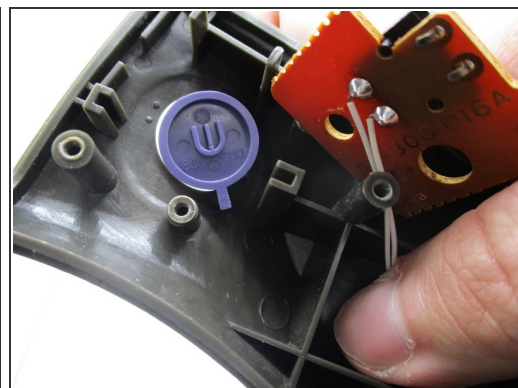
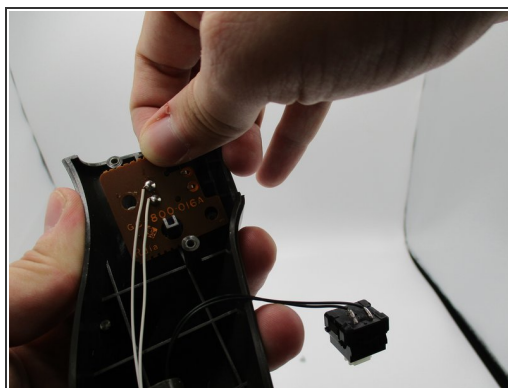
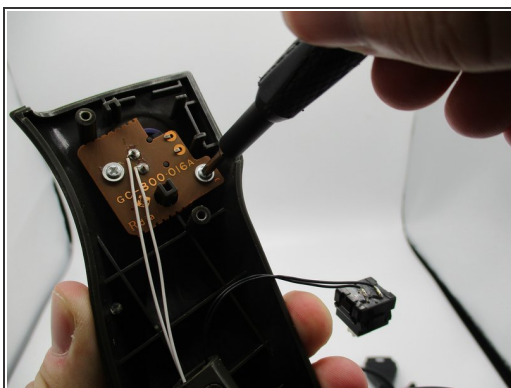
- Remove the three 2 mm screws on the right panel.
  - Remove the right cover panel
  - Open the joystick
-  Open gently to prevent the joystick from falling apart

## Step 2



- Remove the top panel
- Remove the button cap

## Step 3 — Secondary Button Cap



- Unscrew the two silver 1 mm screws
- Remove the circuit board
- Push the purple secondary button cap out from its slot

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
