INTRODUCTION

This guide will help assist replacing the scroll wheel in you Logitech G700s.

TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Magnetic Pickup Tool (1)
- Tweezers (1)

PARTS:

- Replacement G700s Scroll Wheel (1)

Step 1 — Top Case Replacement



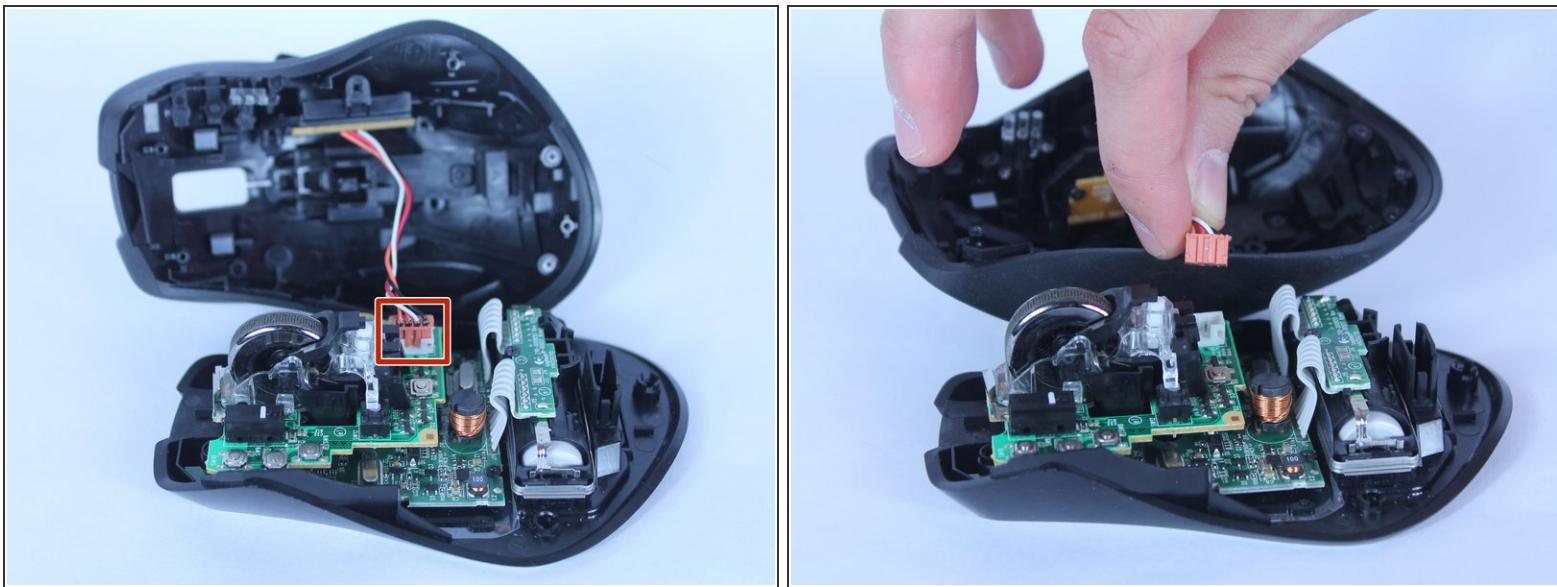
- Remove the batteries from the mouse.
- Use a plastic opening tool to peel up the four mouse feet.

Step 2



- Remove the five 5.5mm Phillips #00 screws found underneath the mouse feet.

Step 3



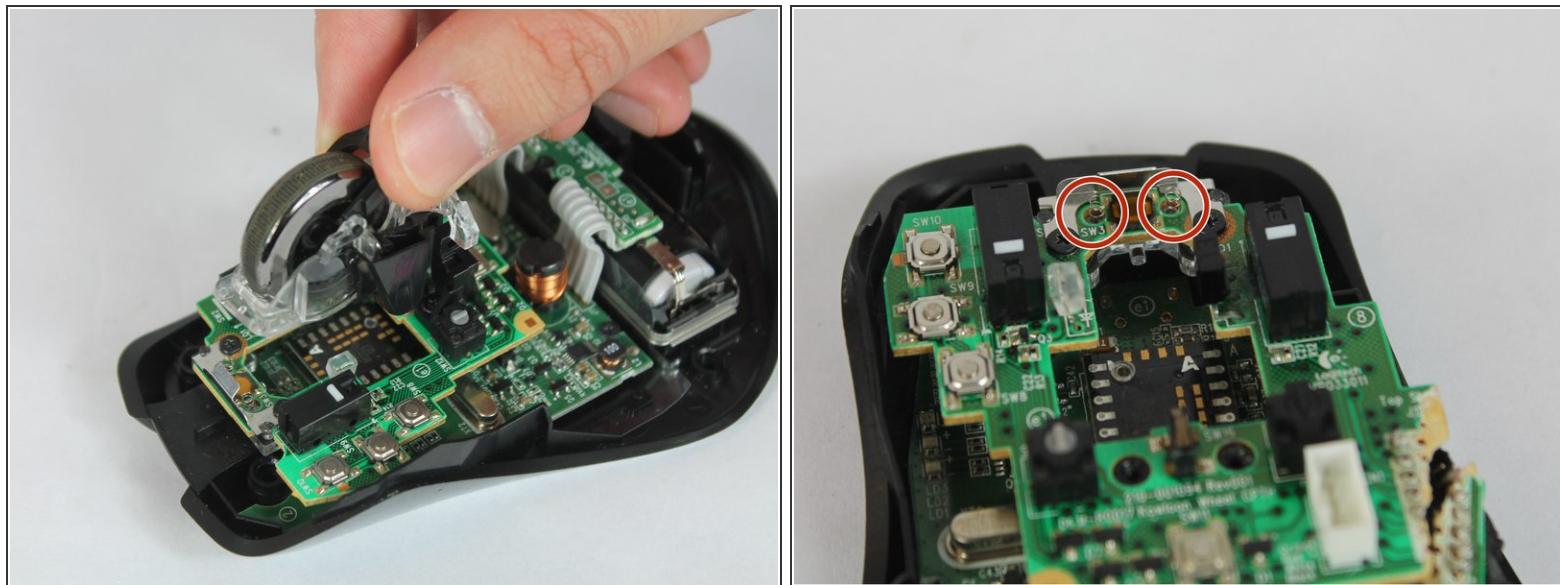
- Pull the top of the mouse off of the bottom half.
 - There's a wire connecting the two halves.
- Unplug the programmable buttons from the motherboard.

Step 4 — Scroll Wheel



- Remove the black pin that holds the scroll wheel to the motherboard.

Step 5



- Lift the scroll wheel straight up off the motherboard.

⚠ Be careful not to lose the two small springs! They are magnetic and could attach to any magnetic tip screw driver!

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
