




Logitech MBJ58 Mouse Buttons Replacement

You will disassemble the mouse top cover and replace the mouse buttons.

INTRODUCTION

After removing the top cover you will be able to replace the mouse buttons.

TOOLS:

- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Top cover





- Hold the mouse so that the bottom is facing up.
- Remove the Phillips #1 screw from the bottom half of the mouse.

Step 2



- Place the mouse so that the bottom is resting against a hard surface.
- Gently lift the top cover of the mouse and remove it.

Step 3 — Buttons




- Locate the two tabs that are protruding from the button assembly.

! Be careful not to break either of the two tabs by squeezing too hard.

- Now pinch the tabs together to free the buttons.

Step 4



- Free the button assembly from the top cover by bringing the button section down.
- Then sliding the button assembly out from the top cover through the opening.

i When fully parted the top cover and the button assembly should look like this.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
