



MacBook Pro 15" Unibody Mid 2012 Lower Case Replacement

Replace the lower case on your MacBook Pro 15" Unibody Mid 2012.

INTRODUCTION

Remove the lower case to access most of your MacBook Pro's internals.

TOOLS:

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

PARTS:

- MacBook Pro 15" Unibody (Mid 2010/Early 2011/Late 2011/Mid 2012) Lower Case (1)
- Macbook Pro Unibody Lower Case Screw Set (1)
- MacBook and MacBook Pro Unibody Plastic Feet (1)

Step 1 — Lower Case



- Remove the following ten screws securing the lower case to the upper case:
 - Three 13.5 mm (14.1 mm) Phillips screws.
 - Seven 3 mm Phillips screws.
-  When removing these screws, note how they come out at a slight angle. They must be reinstalled the same way.

Step 2



- Using both hands, lift the lower case near the vent to pop it off two clips securing it to the upper case.
- Remove the lower case and set it aside.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
