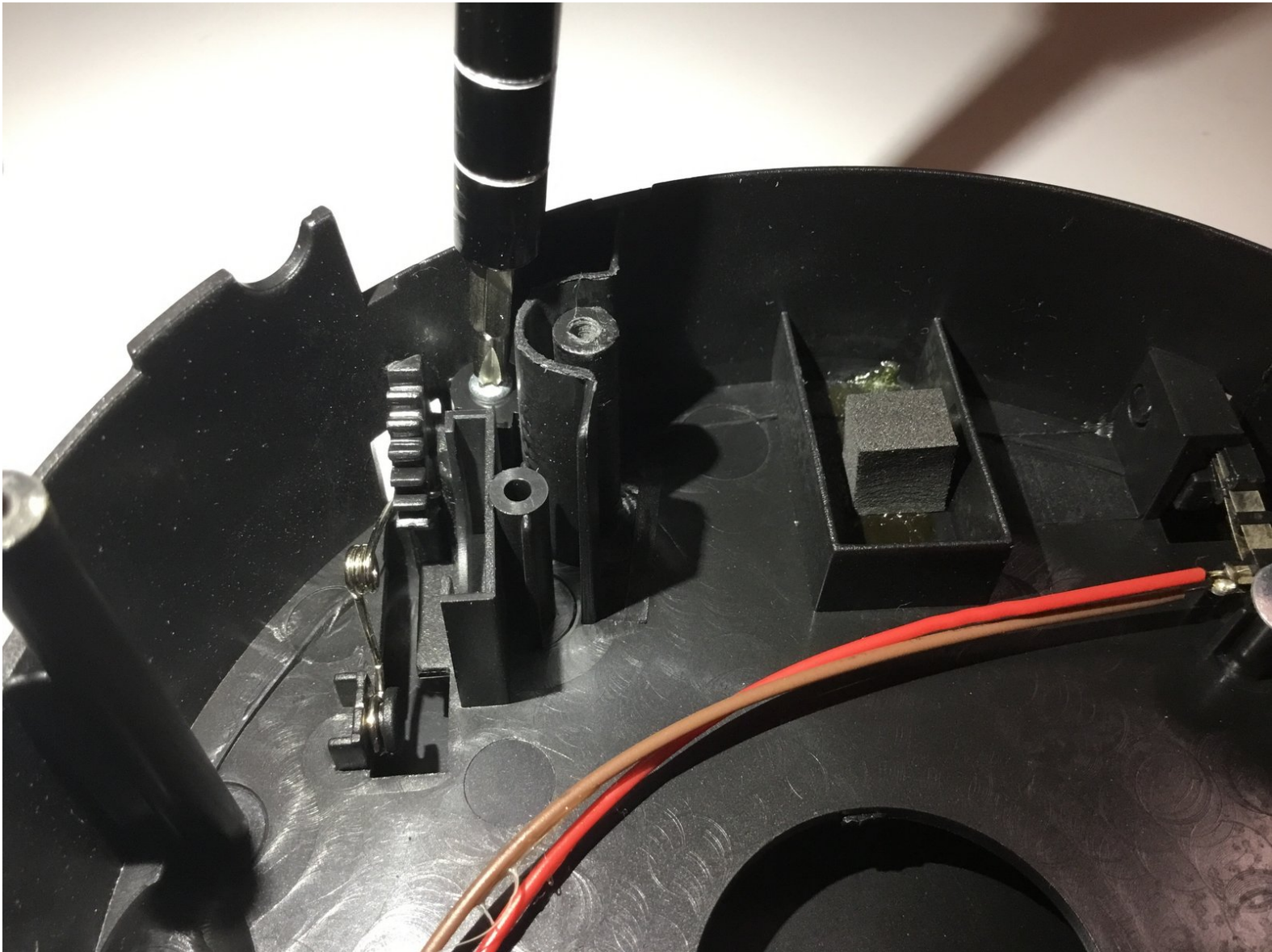




Memorex CD Alarm Clock Radio CD Lid Spring Replacement

INTRODUCTION

These steps will instruct you on removing a broken spring and replace it with a new one.



TOOLS:

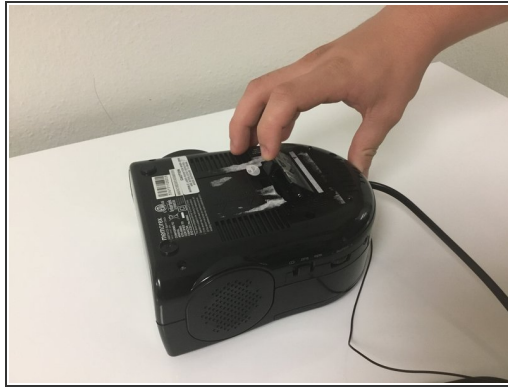
- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)
- [Tweezers](#) (1)
- [Flathead 3/32" or 2.5 mm Screwdriver](#) (1)

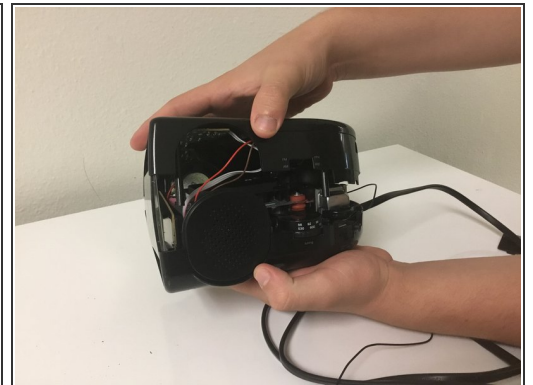

Step 1 — Memorex CD Alarm Clock Radio Disassembly



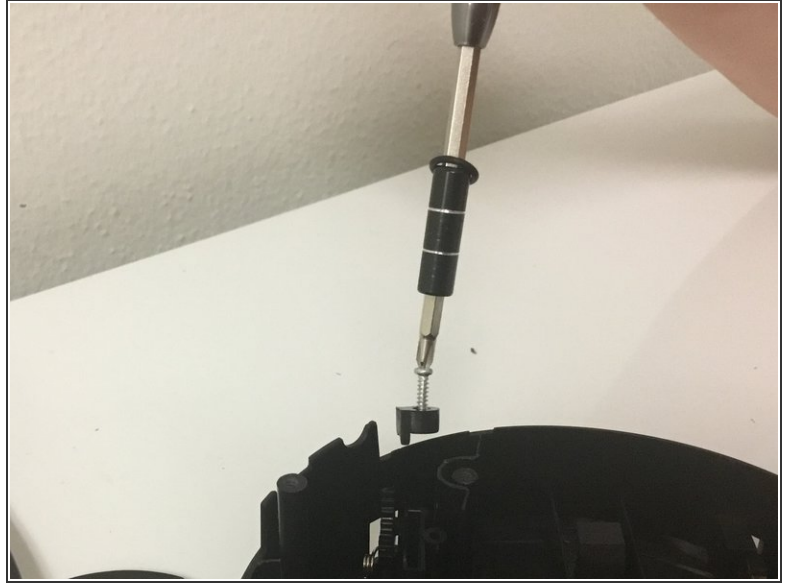
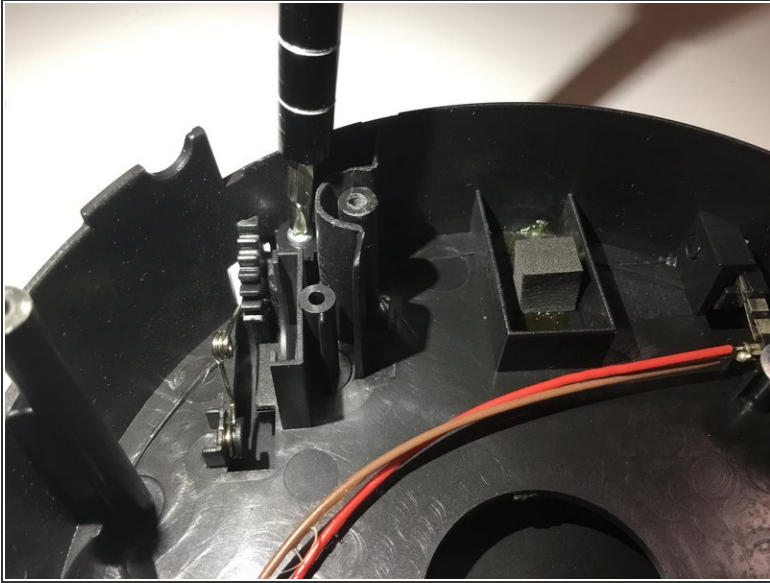
- Locate the 'OPEN' tab on the battery compartment.
- Pull the tab upwards and remove the cover using your finger.
- Remove the batteries.

Step 2



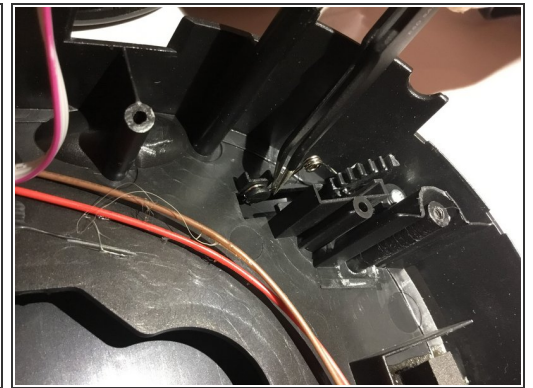
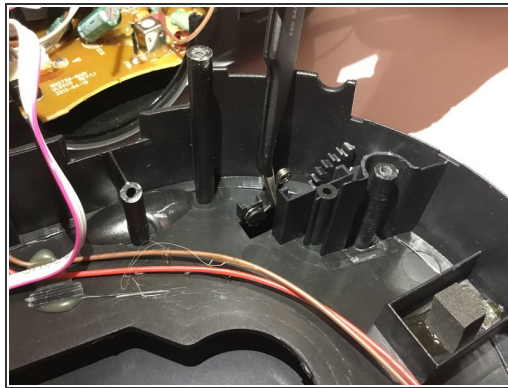
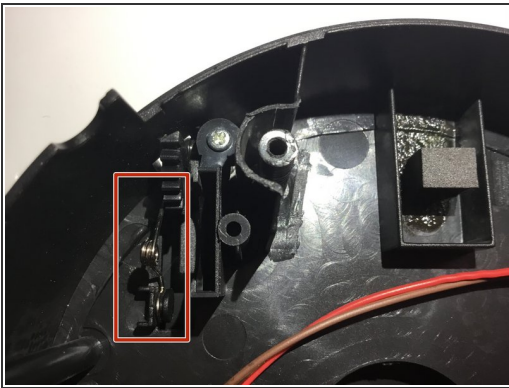
- Locate the screws on the bottom of the device that hold the upper and lower halves together.
- Remove the (5) 19mm screws.
- Grasp the top and bottom and gently pull apart.

Step 3 — CD Lid Spring



- Remove screw with plastic retaining plastic piece.

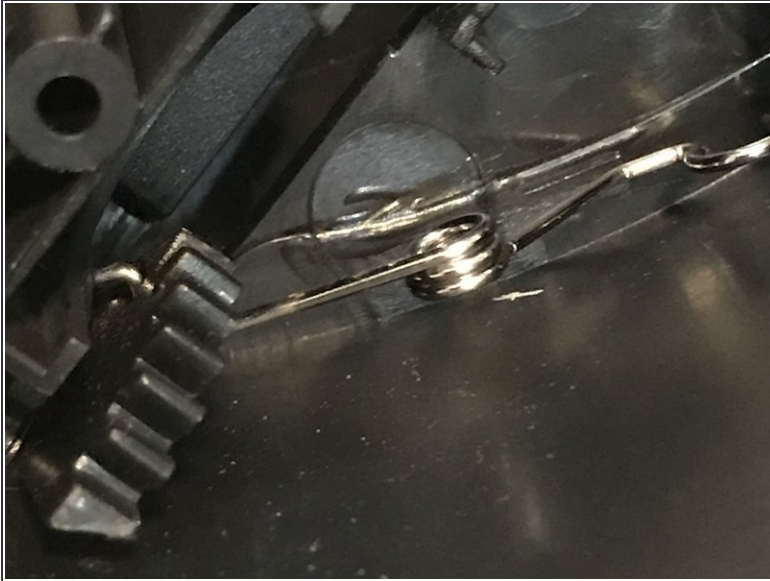
Step 4



- Grasp and remove the spring using fine tip tweezers.

i The spring is very small and can be lost easily.

Step 5



- Remove the spring with a flat tip screwdriver.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
