INTRODUCTION

If you are wondering why your tool is not cutting properly, you may have a worn blade. This is a simple procedure on how to remove the blade, which is an important component to the angle grinder. A variety of wheels and attachments are available for the grinder to perform certain tasks.

Step 1 — Blade



- In order to remove the flange nut you must turn it counter-clockwise.
- Once the nut is removed, take off the old blade and install a new one.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
