This guide shows how to replace the battery in the parent unit of your baby monitor.

INTRODUCTION

The Parent Unit is powered by a rechargeable lithium ion type of battery. These batteries have an average lifespan of 2-3 years or 300-500 charges. This guide will show you how to replace the battery once it has reached its life expectancy.

TOOLS:

- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- Using the Phillips #1 screwdriver, remove the battery cover screw.
- Remove the battery cover from its hinges and set aside.

Step 2



- Lift the battery from its slot.
- Using precision tweezers, grip the connector plug.
- Wiggle the connector plug and pull up to remove the connecting wires.
- Remove the battery from the unit and set it aside.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
