



Motorola Moto G XT1034 Back Case and Battery Cover Disassembly

Disassembly guide that leads you to the "heart" of your phone.

 **TOOLS:**

- [T5 Torx Screwdriver \(1\)](#)

Step 1 — Rear Panel



- **(i)** Before you start following any of the steps of this guide, completely turn the device off.
- Take the plastic back cover off by either using a plastic Pry tool or simply using your hands. Start from the bottom by the charging port

Step 2 — Removing the Screws



- Unscrew the 3.5mm screws, total of 14, located on the back protective cover by using a T5 Torx screwdriver.

Step 3 — Removing the Battery Cover



- Use a plastic opening tool to remove the protective cover.

! Carefully work the plastic tool around all the edges of the phone.

i The protective cover holds the Volume and the Home buttons which might fall off the assembly when the cover is removed.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
