## INTRODUCTION

This guide will walk you through the process of replacing a faulty LCD screen in a Motorola Moto G4 Plus phone.



## Step 1 — LCD Screen



- Using a heating pad, hair dryer, or heat gun, heat up the edges of the LCD screen.

## Step 2



- Lift up the front facing camera to make room for a spudger.
- With the LCD screen still warm, use a spudger to push on the screen from the gap created by lifting up the front facing camera .
- Wedge a card or other thin object in the screen separation.



## Step 3



- Slide the card or other object around the perimeter of the screen to maximize separation.

## Step 4



- Lift up the two orange cables connecting the screen to the phone.
- Remove the screen.
