



# Motorola V60c Side Buttons Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

How to replace the side buttons.

### TOOLS:

- [iFixit Opening Tools](#) (1)
- [T6 Torx Screwdriver](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Battery



- Depress the silver button.
- Pull from top of phone to lift the cover.

## Step 2



- Hold battery from both sides at the bottom.
- Push upwards and gently lift to remove.

## Step 3 — Side Buttons



- Remove 4 screws from corners using T-6 screwdriver.

*(i)* NOTE: Bottom two screws are gold.

*(i)* NOTE: Make sure screws return to correct place when reassembling.

## Step 4



- Use a plastic opening tool to pry up back cover from two side clips.



*(i)* NOTE: sticker might be attached to rest of phone.

## Step 5




- Remove the back cover.

## Step 6



- Use a plastic opening tool to gently remove the orange ribbon cable.
- Lift up the main logic board.
- NOTE: Rubber side buttons are not secure and might detach from the main logic board during removal.

## Step 7



- Carefully flip over main logic board.
- Remove rubber side buttons.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
