



Mt. Fury Roadmaster Pedal Replacement

This guide will serve to assist in removing and replacing the pedal from the Mt. Fury Roadmaster.

INTRODUCTION

If you have a broken pedal or desire pedal clips this guide will assist you in removing and replacing your pedals.

TOOLS:

- 15mm open-end wrench (1)

PARTS:

- Pedal (2)

Step 1 — Pedal



- Flip the bicycle upside down so that the bicycle rests on the seat and handlebars. The bike should be able to stay standing on its own.

Step 2



- Locate the 15mm pedal nut, and position the crank arms for maximum leverage.
- Using a 15mm open-end wrench, brace the opposite pedal with your other hand and remove the pedal nut from the crank arm.

 A considerable amount of force may be required to break pedal nut free.

To install new pedal, follow these instructions in reverse order.
