




# Nokia 6590i Logic Board Replacement


## INTRODUCTION

This guide will show how to remove the phone's logic board.

### TOOLS:


- [Spudger \(1\)](#)
- [T6 Torx Screwdriver \(1\)](#)

## Step 1 — Battery



- Press the button to remove the back cover.
- Pull the cover downward and lift it off while still pressing the button.

## Step 2



- Lift the battery out of the phone by pushing down from the top and pulling out

## Step 3 — Keypad, Speaker, and Screen Assembly



- Grip the front cover from the bottom.

## Step 4



- Lift the front cover off.

## Step 5




- Locate 6 screws on front of assembly and unscrew them using a T6 torx screwdriver.

## Step 6




- Insert spudger along edge of assembly and gently lift assembly away from case

## Step 7




- Remove assembly from phone

## Step 8 — Logic Board



- The logic board now sits on top of the phone.

## Step 9



- Lift the logic board out of the phone.
