Step 1 — find cold water supply to faucet



- Cold water is the supply line is on the right. Turn it off before starting.

Step 2 — Parts needed less than \$100



- Pentek 10" filter and slimline housing
- 3/8" compression supply line and 3/8" faucet supply line
- Filter wrench
- 3/8" compression to 3/8" pipe thread fittings (two), 3/8" close nipple, and 3/8" female elbow (if needed). Total less than

Step 3 — Assemble and install



- use teflon tape on male threads when assembling. do not overtighten.
- Enjoy filtered water for less than a penny a gallon.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
