### TOOLS:

## Step 1 — Opening the case



- The handle to open your computer is located on top of the right side panel.

## Step 2



- Grab the circular handle and pull outward.



## Step 3



- Your computer is now open and ready for repair.

## Step 4 — Hard Drive



- The hard drive is located in the rear right corner of the case.

## Step 5



- Unplug the IDE ribbon cable. This is the wide flat grey cable.

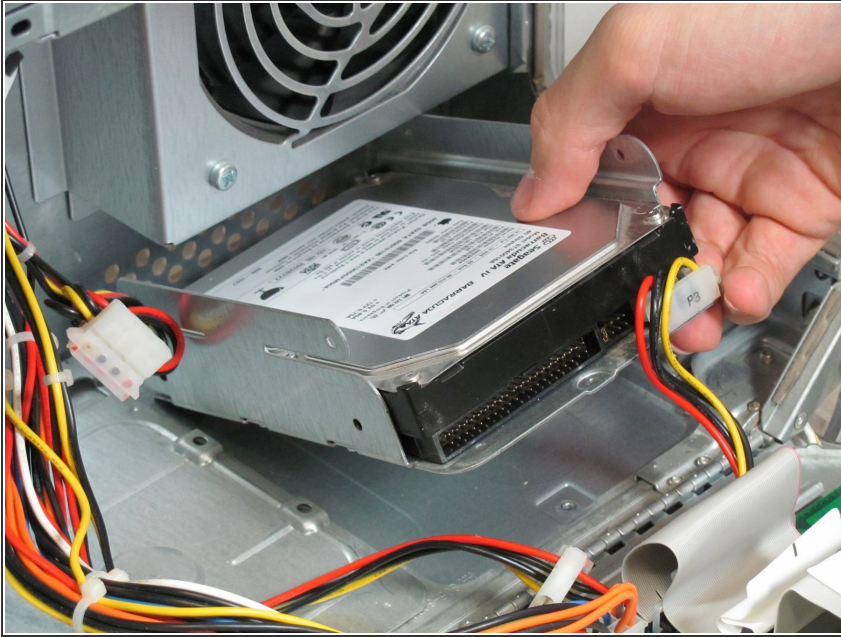
## Step 6



- Remove the screw holding down the hard drive enclosure.

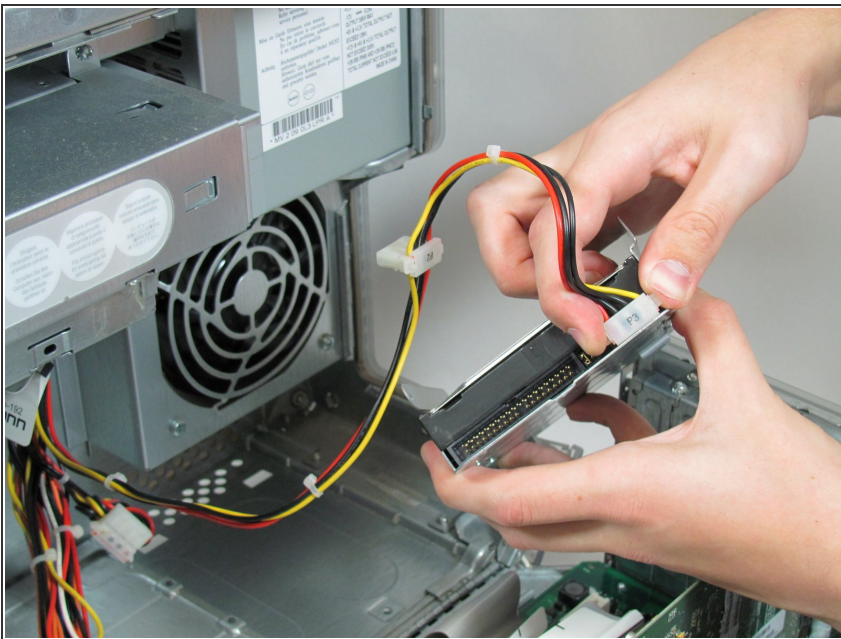


## Step 7



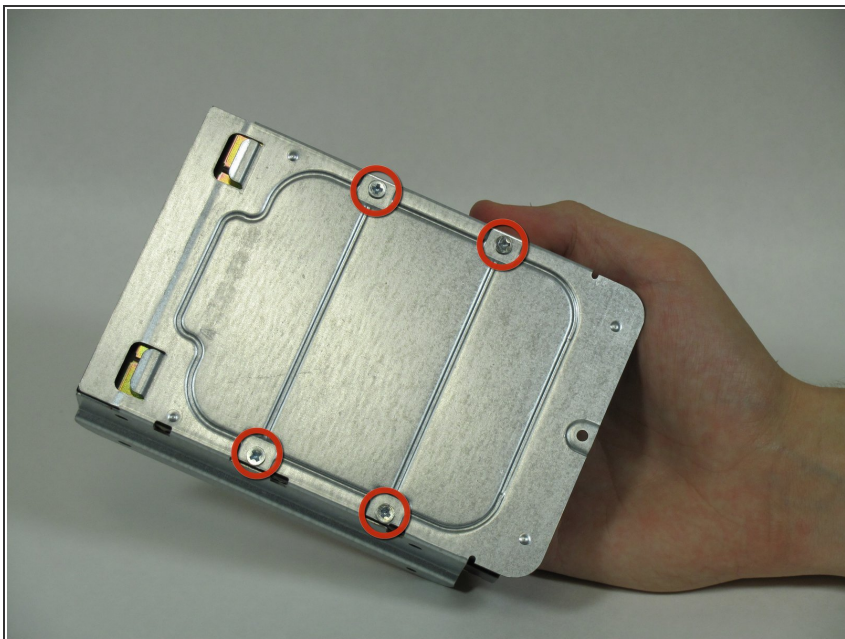
- Lift the hard drive enclosure straight up and out.
- ⓘ Be careful not to pull the attached cable.

## Step 8



- Disconnect the MOLEX connector.
- ⓘ This cable may be hard to remove. Grab the connector on either side as pictured and wiggle it back and forth to remove it.

## Step 9



- Remove the four screws holding the hard drive to the enclosure.

## Step 10



- Your hard drive is now free from the enclosure and is ready to be replaced.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
