Step 1 — Sand Belt



- Orient the device with the underside of the sander exposed and facing you.

Step 2



- Pull the lever located on the right side of the sander all the way back.

Step 3



- Gently remove the belt from the sander.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
