INTRODUCTION

This guide explains how to replace the USB port in the Razer Blackwidow Tournament Edition keyboard.

TOOLS:

- Metal Spudger (1)
- Mako Driver Kit - 64 Precision Bits (1)

Step 1 — USB Port Board




- Remove the four plastic covers and rubber feet from the corners of the keyboard.
- Remove the four screws.

Step 2





- Turn the keyboard face up.
 - Remove the four screws which attach the keys.
- Note the orientation of the white plastic cover relative to the LED at the bottom of the board.

Step 3



- Locate the USB at the top of the device.
 - Remove the two screws attaching the USB.

Step 4



- Unplug the cable connecting to the USB board.
 - Plug the new USB board into the slot.
 - Replace the screws in the USB board.
