## INTRODUCTION

To begin, make sure to remove the battery before doing anything else.


### TOOLS:

- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

### PARTS:


- 750 GB Hybrid Seagate Hard Drive (New) (1)

## Step 1 — Battery




- ⚠ Make sure that the computer is turned off and is disconnected from external power source.
- Turn it upside down and locate the battery release switch.

## Step 2



- While holding the switch in the open position, lift out the battery.
- ⓘ If you plan to work on any internal laptop components, press and hold the power button for 5 seconds. This will dissipate any residual charge on the motherboard to prevent electrical shock when you begin to handle it.


## Step 3 — Hard Drive



- Remove the two Phillips #1 screws on the left side of the computer, just above the battery compartment.

*(i)* These screws hold the hard drive tray into the hard drive compartment.

## Step 4



- Slide the hard drive tray out of the hard drive compartment.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
