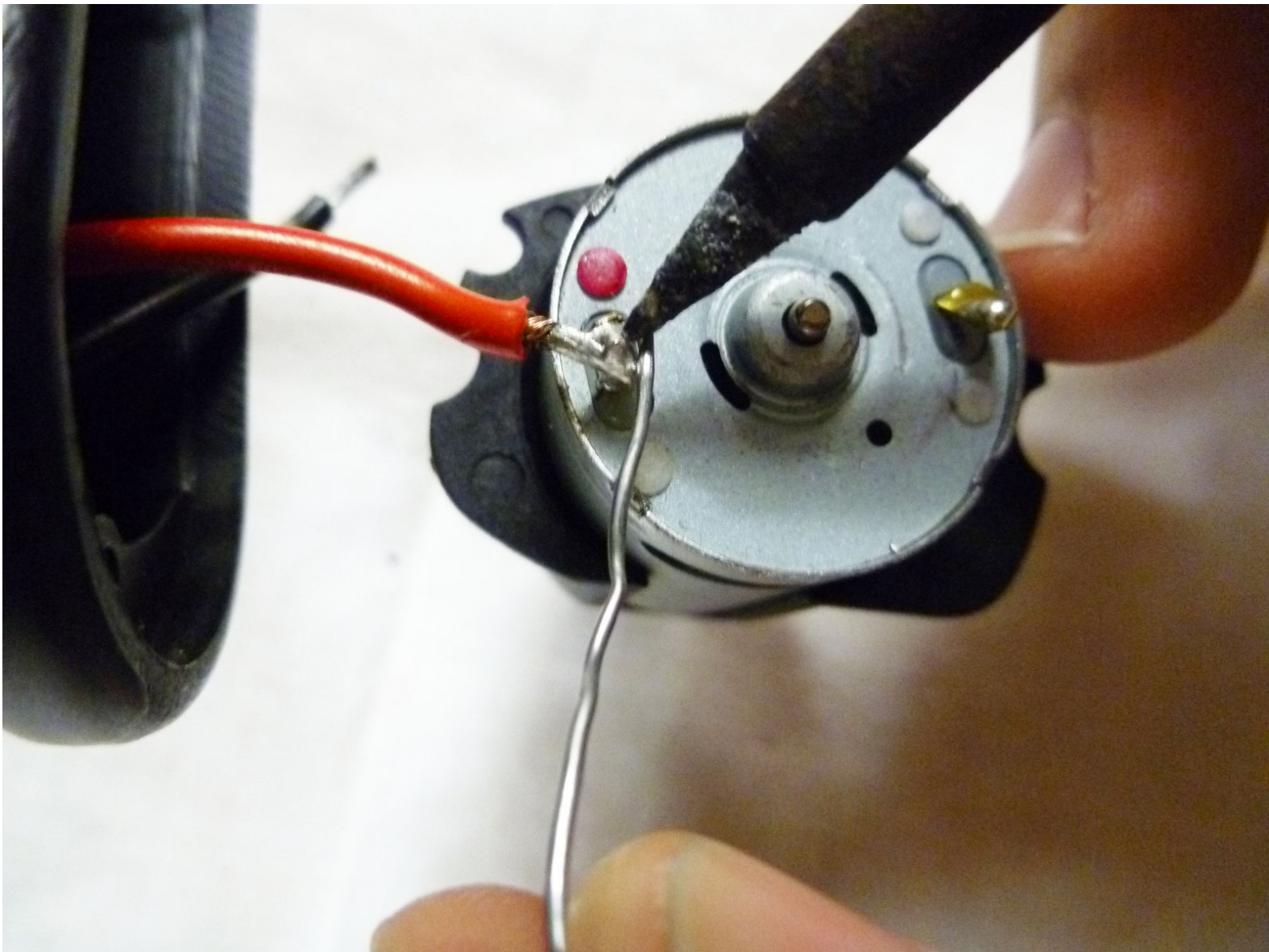




SG 552-1 Commando Motor Replacement

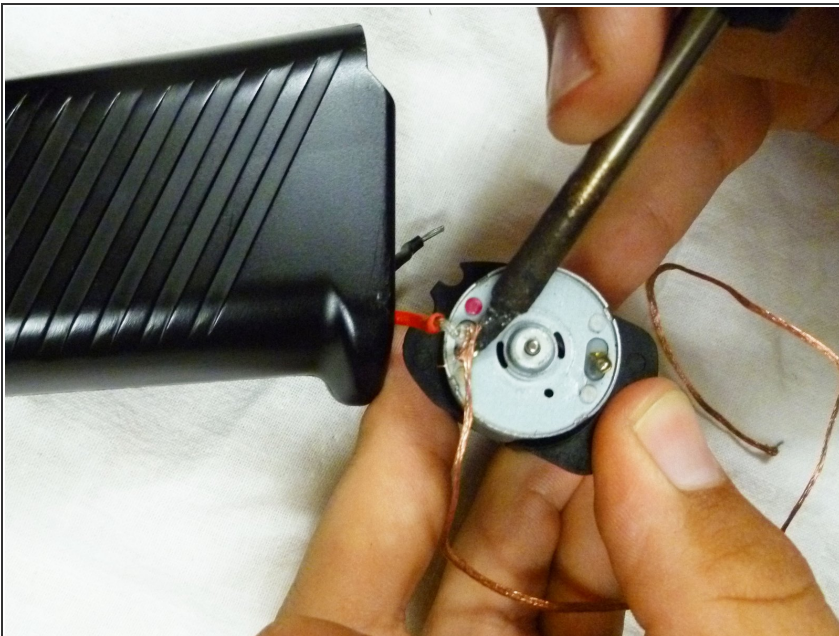

Step 1 — Motor



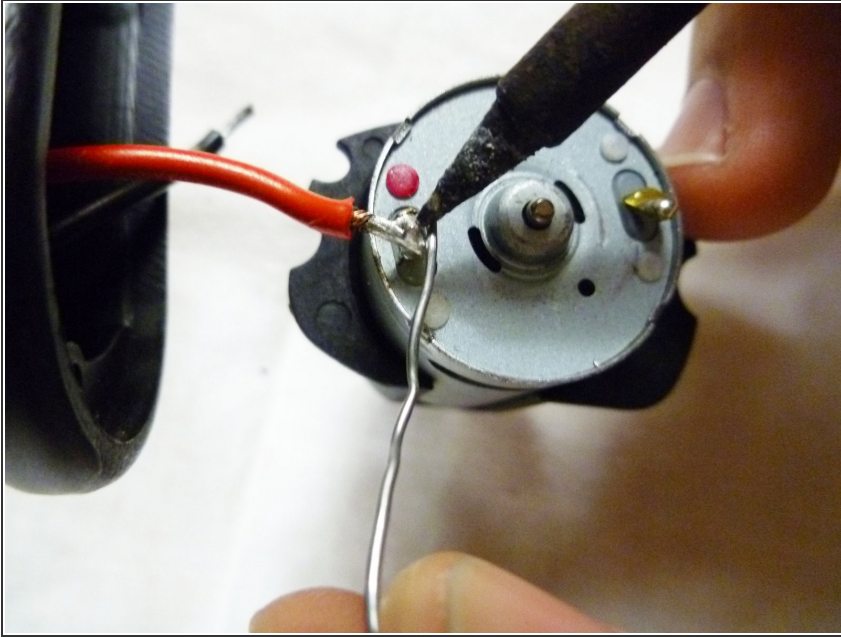
- Using a Phillips #0 screwdriver, remove the two 6mm screws located at the bottom of the hand grip.
- Slide the cover off.

Step 2



- Pull the motor out from the inside of the hand grip.
- Using a soldering iron and desoldering wick, desolder the wires from the motor.

Step 3



- Using a soldering iron, solder the wires onto the new motor.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
