

- Posidriv #1 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Piston Head Seals / O-rings



- I show you the O-rings in the top piston of the brewgroup. I don't write much, because my english is bad, but the photos speak for themselves. Good luck
- Two screws, PZ 1
- Careful, there is a spring.

- Spring, O-ring and a GLASBALL.

Step 5




- Screw PZ 1
- Counterrotate turning the screw.
- Then pull that thing and you find another seal

Step 6





- There are two types of O-rings. For this type of piston you need the smaller.

- Grease it a liitle.
- Just put it back, no problem.

Step 10



- ...and then I found a crack in my piston. That can not be repaired. So I had to buy a new piston.
