
INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to replace the motherboard of a Samsung Blast. This guide will take you through the process of how to successfully remove and replace the motherboard. A motherboard may need replacement if the device stops working.

TOOLS:

- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)
- [Tweezers](#) (1)
- [iFixit Opening Tools](#) (1)

Step 1 — Motherboard



- Remove the battery cover by pushing it upwards.

Step 2



- Take out the battery.

Step 3




- With a Phillips #00 screwdriver, remove the six screws that secure the back of the case.
- (i)* You will not be able to completely remove the top two screws. Simply loosen them enough that you can still remove the cover.

Step 4




- Pull off the back cover of the phone.

Step 5





- Remove the volume and camera buttons by pulling them out.
- ▣ Put the buttons aside until it is time to reassemble the phone.

Step 6



- Use the small plastic opening tool to gently remove the motherboard from the rest of the phone.

Step 7



- Gently grab the motherboard with tweezers, then disconnect it from the two attached plates.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
