INTRODUCTION

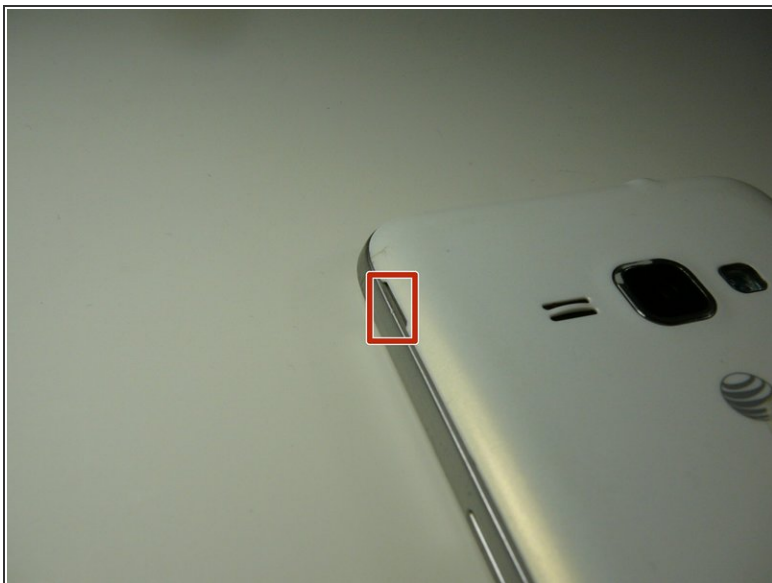
In the steps shown below, you will easily be able to replace the SIM Card in the phone with a new (or old) SIM Card. This can happen due to a change of service providers or a new service plan.

Step 1 — Battery



- Starting from the indent, use a finger nail or guitar pick to separate the back from the body of the phone.

Step 2




- Once the cover is removed you'll find the battery that reads "SAMSUNG"
 - Use a fingernail or a plastic tool such as a guitar pick to lift up on the bottom indent of the battery.
- ⚠ Do not use metal tool as it can be dangerous.

Step 3 — SIM Card



- Use a finger nail, guitar pick, or a plastic tool such as the one shown to slide out the SIM Card to the right.

 Do not use metal tool as it can cause damage to SIM Card or internal parts of phone.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
