



Samsung Galaxy Tab A 8.0 Digitizer Replacement

A Guide on how to replace the Digitizer only.

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TOOLS:

 - [Soft Cloth](#) (1)
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Step 1 — Digitizer



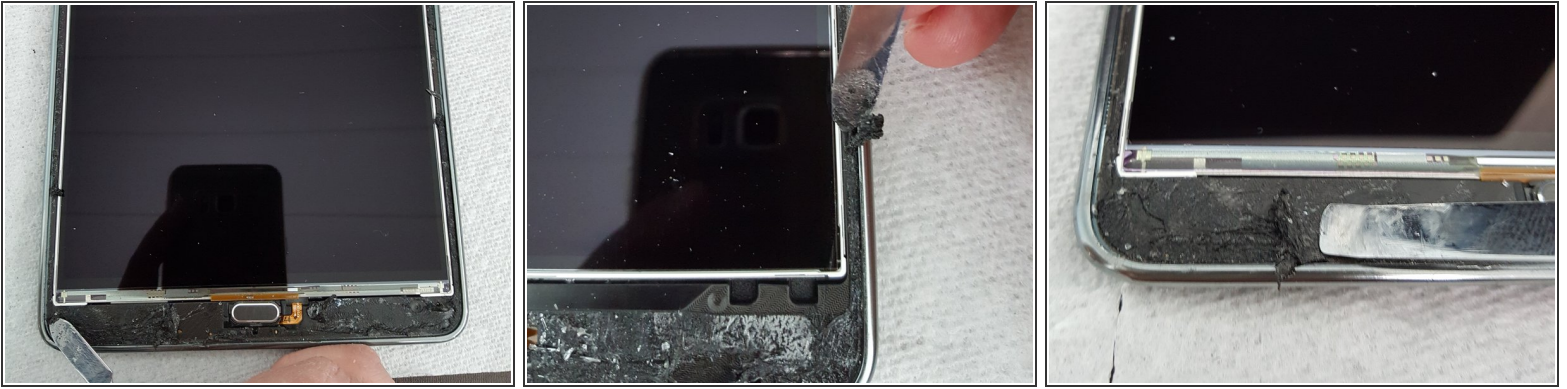
- First thing I did was put Packing Tape on cracked screen so when I removed digitizer broken glass wouldn't go everywhere. I then used a Hairdryer to heat the tablet so I can remove the screen. Next time I will use a heat gun, will work much better.

Step 2



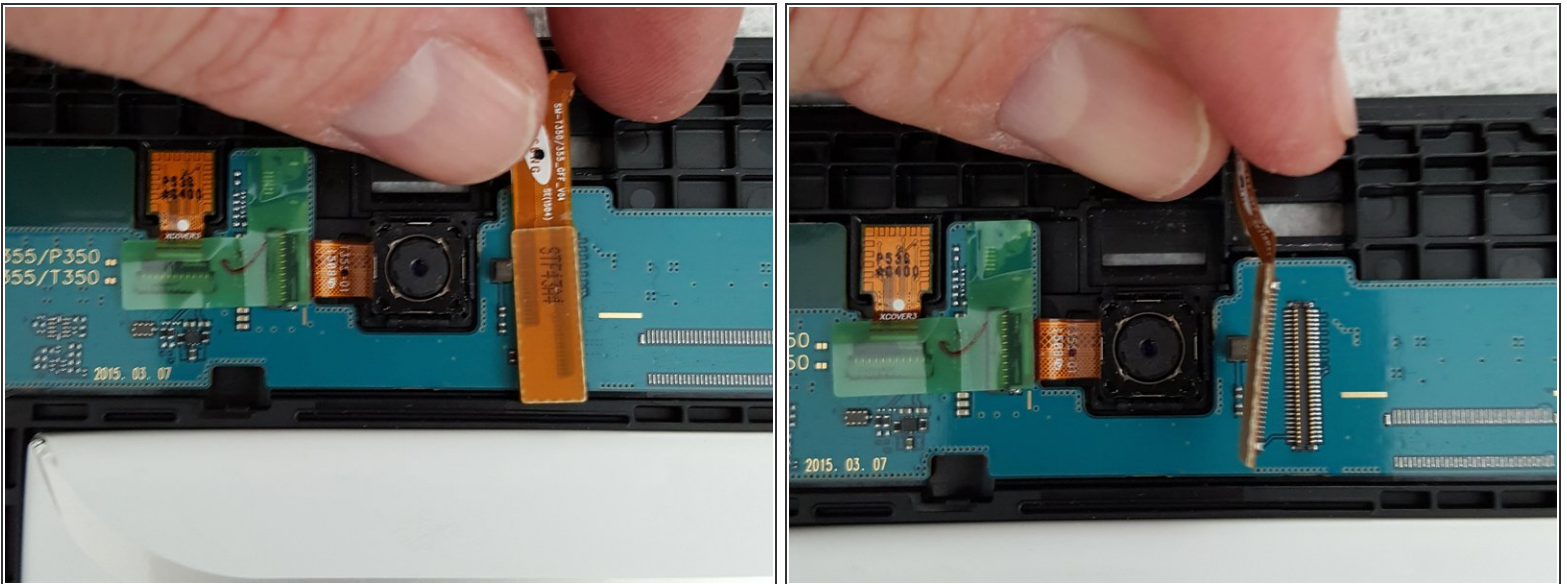
- Screen finally came off, but I broke the cable from the old Digitizer. That's ok, you don't need it anyway

Step 3



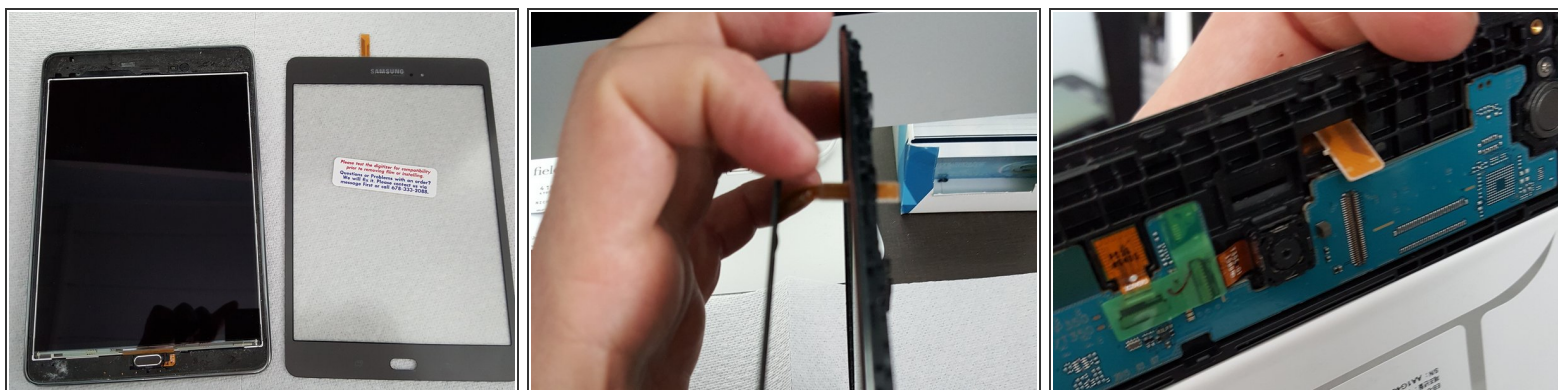
- Removing adhesive with Metal Spudger. Tape was really sticky, took a good 20 minutes to clean off

Step 4



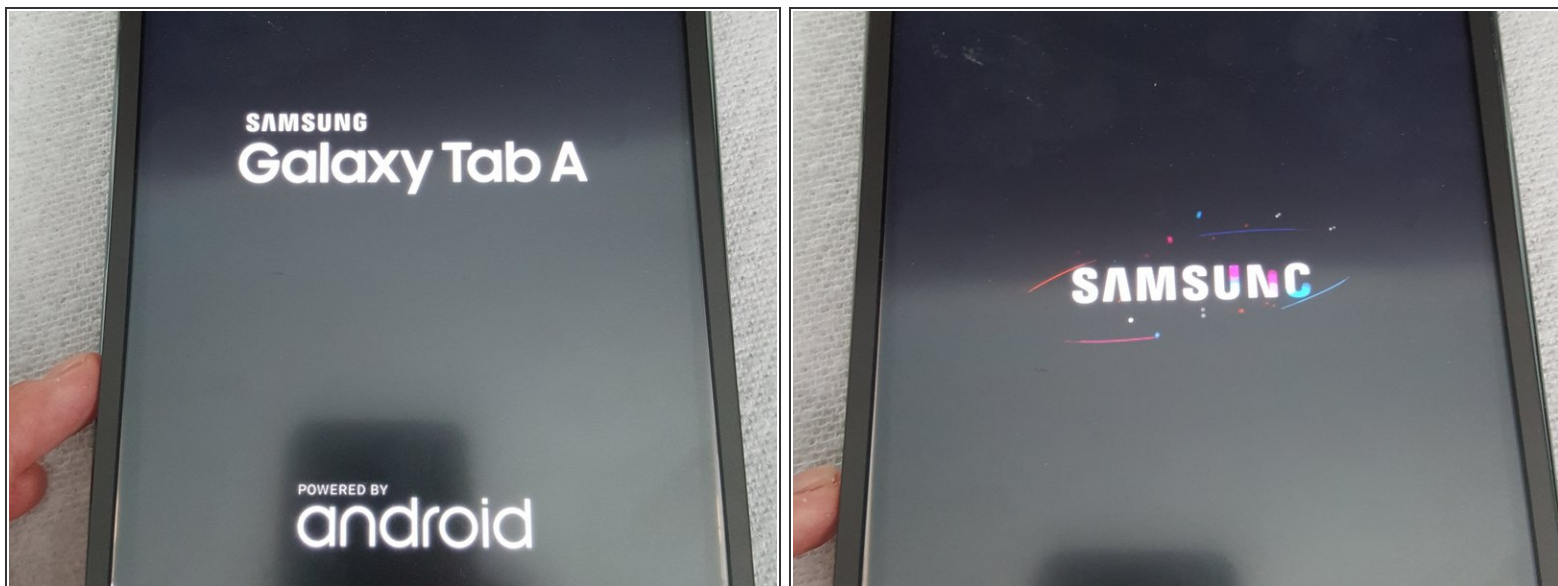
- Next I removed Digitizer cable from back of tablet. Just pull it slightly and it comes right off.

Step 5



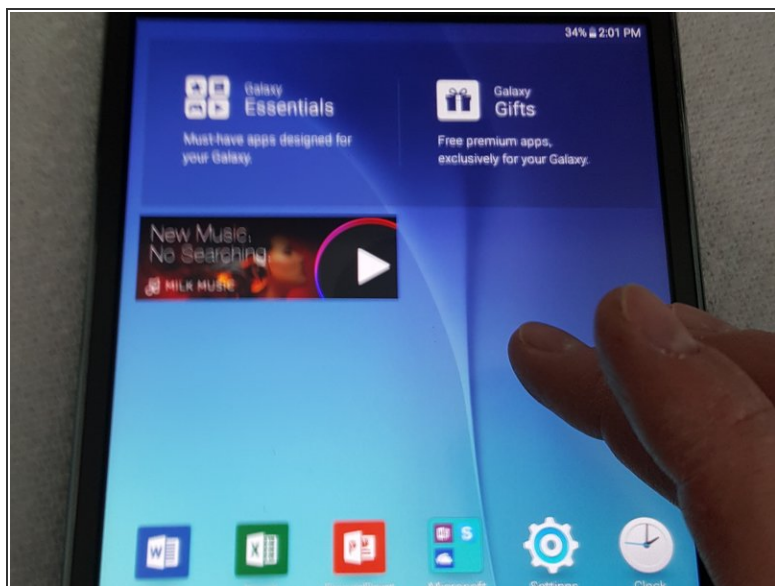
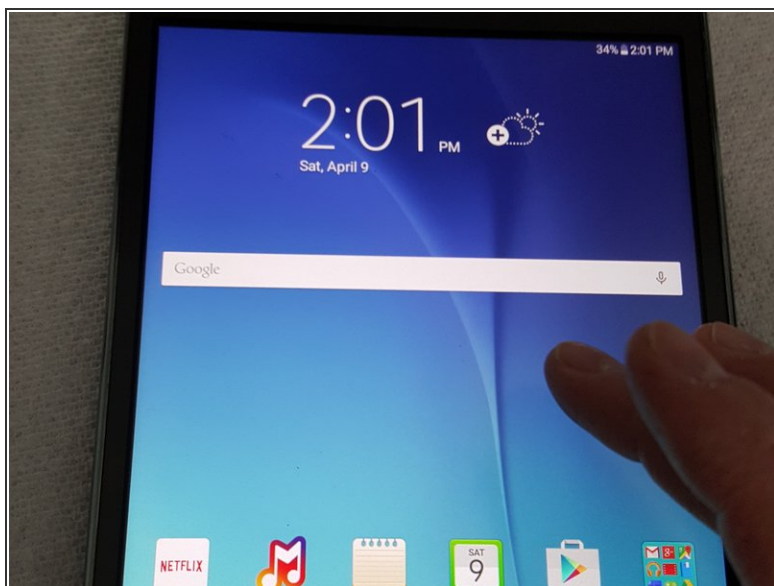
- Time to put on new Digitizer. Stand up the Digitizer and Tablet and put the Digitizer cable through the hole to the back and plug in.

Step 6



- Power on and test to see if it powers up ok.

Step 7



- Test the touch to see if everything works ok.

Step 8



- Install Digitizer with LCD on bottom cover and snap together, be careful when closing it.

Step 9



- I pushed the Digitizer in gently and it cracked! Cant believe it. Looks like I need to get another Digitizer. I turned it on and everything works great though, but im back to square one.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
