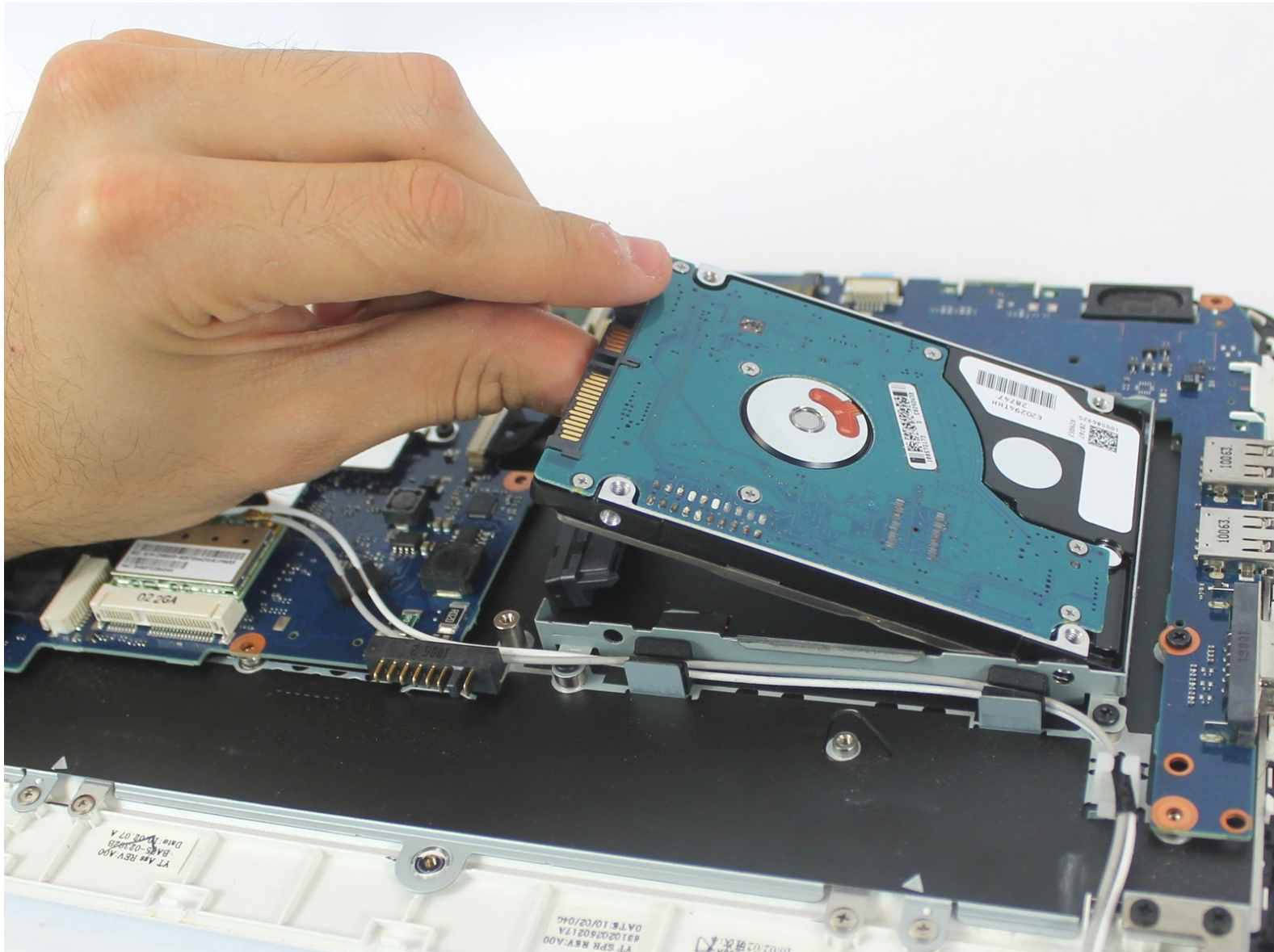




Samsung NP-N210-JA02US Hard Drive Replacement

INTRODUCTION

Follow this guide to replace/upgrade your hard drive.

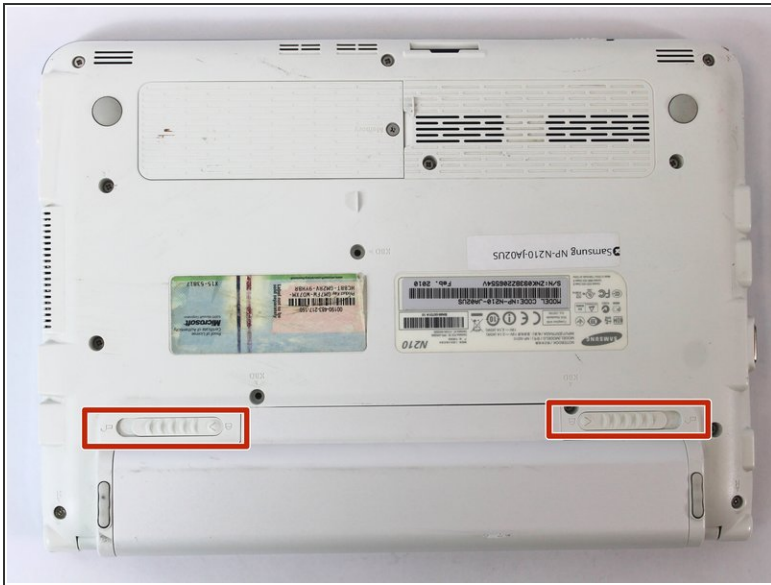
A hard drive replacement is helpful if your device is won't boot or crashes continually. Make sure your replacement hard drive is compatible with the Samsung NP-N210-JA02US.

Step 1 — Battery



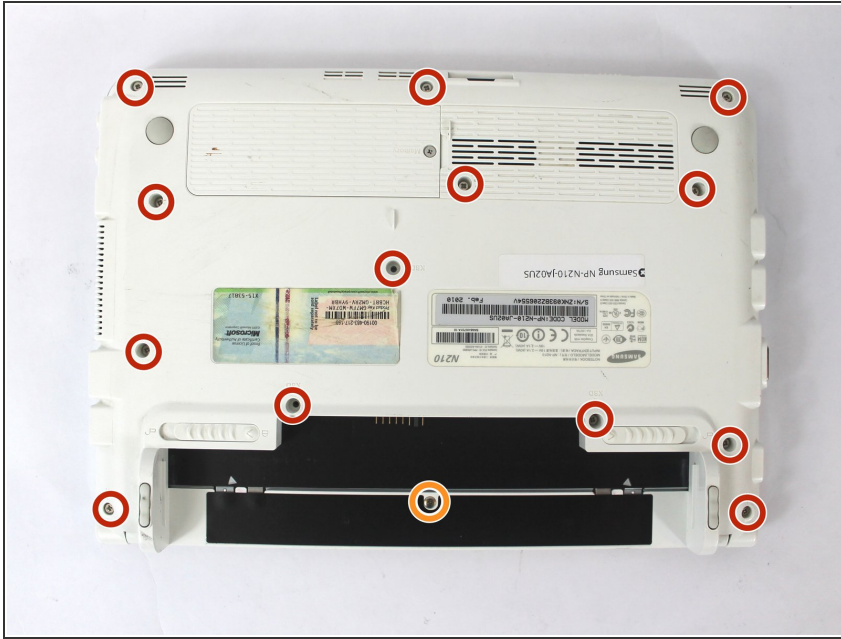
- Carefully slide both locking pins to the unlocked position.

Step 2



- Slide the battery out of its housing.

Step 3 — Hard Drive Removal



- Remove the following 14 screws:
- Thirteen 5 mm Phillips #1 screws
- One 3.5 mm Phillips #001 screw

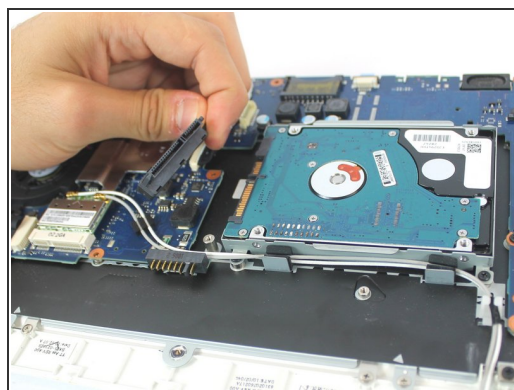
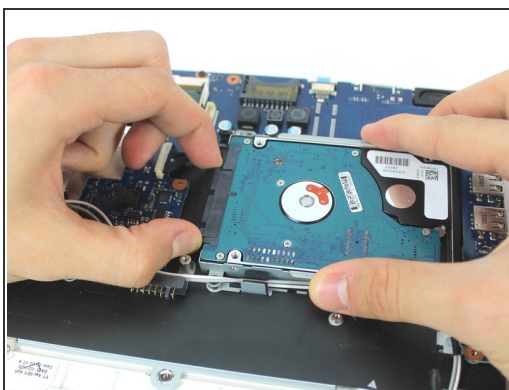
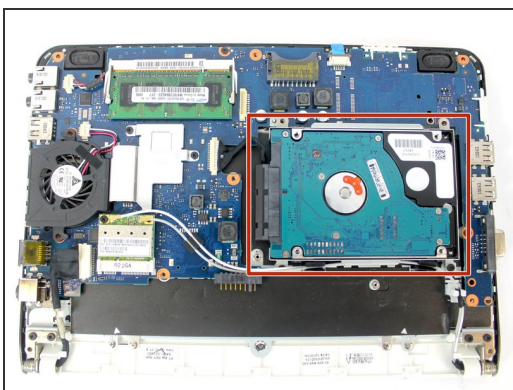
- Carefully insert the plastic opening tool into the seam between the lower casing and the chrome bezel.

Step 5



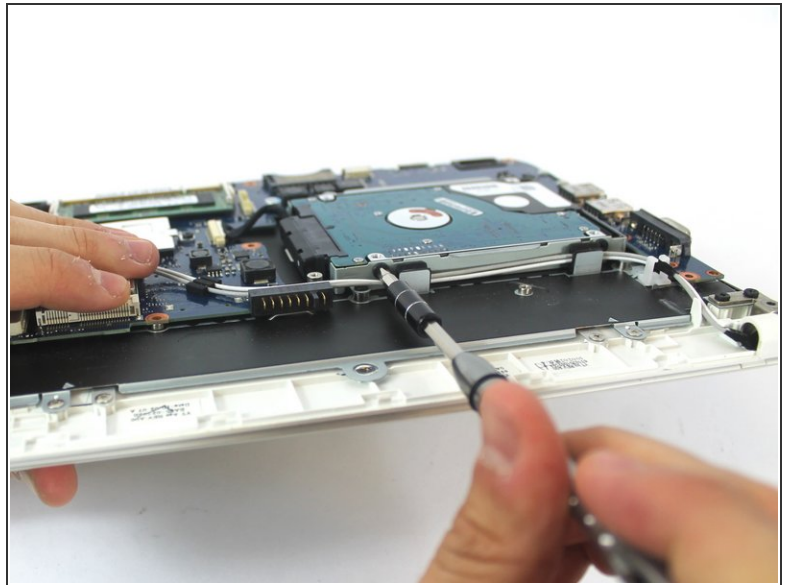
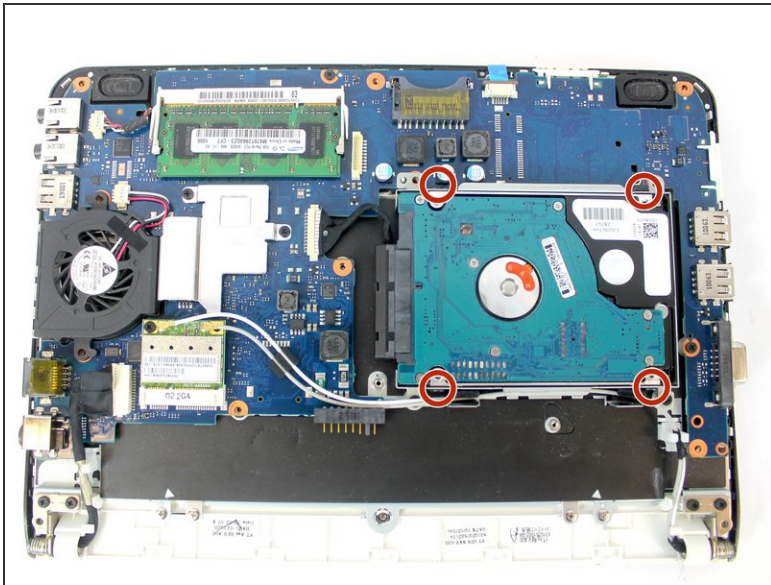
- Slide the opening tool across all sides of the lower case. Then, lift it up to remove the case and reveal the internal components.

Step 6



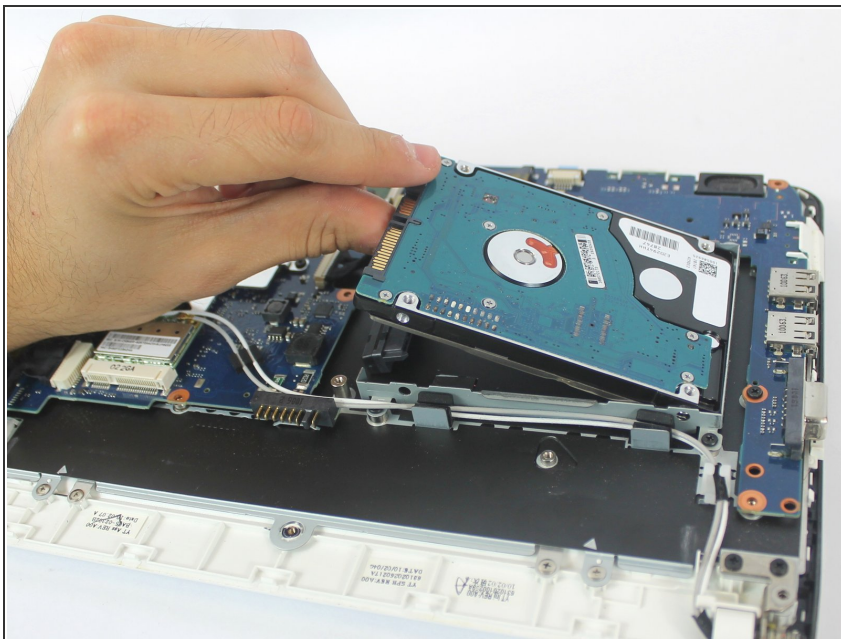
- Carefully unplug the SATA connector from the hard drive.

Step 7



- Remove the four black 3.5 mm Philips #1 screws on the (side) of the hard drive.

Step 8



- Gently lift the hard drive from its mounting bracket.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
