



Shark ION Robot R75 Main Brush Replacement

This is a simple guide for the replacement of the main brush of the Shark ION Robot R75.

INTRODUCTION

The main brush of the Shark ION Robot R75 collects debris both from the path of the vacuum and from the side brushes. The main brush can become worn, dirty, or wrapped up with debris (especially hair) over time. When the debris buildup becomes too significant, the brush can have difficulty spinning, which will impede performance. Periodic inspection and cleaning of the side brush is necessary to keep the R75 in its optimal performance, so use this guide to both access the main brush for cleaning, or to replace it once the brush becomes too worn.

Step 1 — Main Brush



- Push on the two tabs on the edge of the main brush cover and pull up to remove the cover.

Step 2



- Pull the main brush slightly to the right to remove it from the compartment.

Step 3



- Remove the rubber end cap indicated by the red circle.

 This step is not needed for a replacement. However, it is important for maintenance. Hair will build up in this area over time, and will cause error messages to pop up, as well as stopping the R75 from cleaning and moving.

 Inspect this component at least every six months. This time may be less if you have animals.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
