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INTRODUCTION

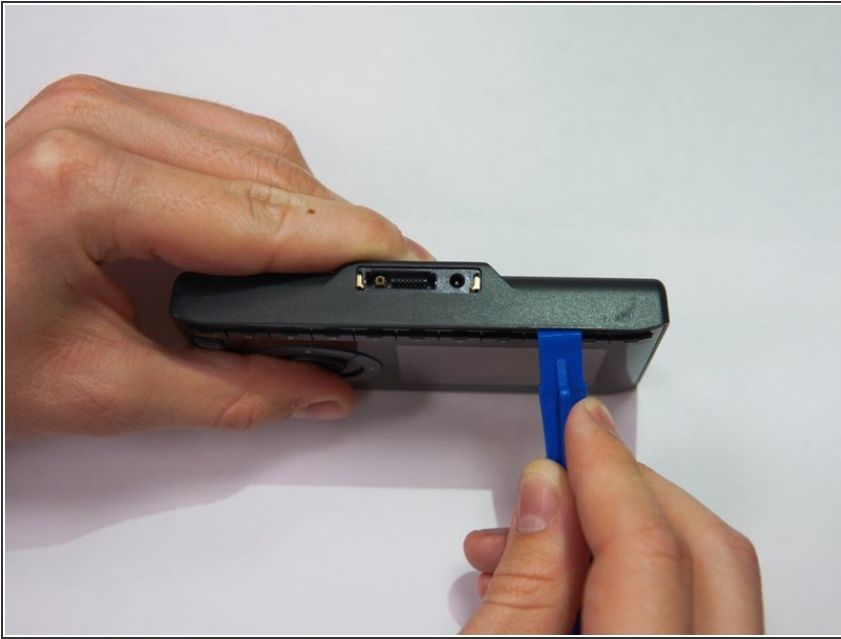
The casing of the device can sometimes crack. This guide will show you how to take apart the device and replace the casing.



TOOLS:

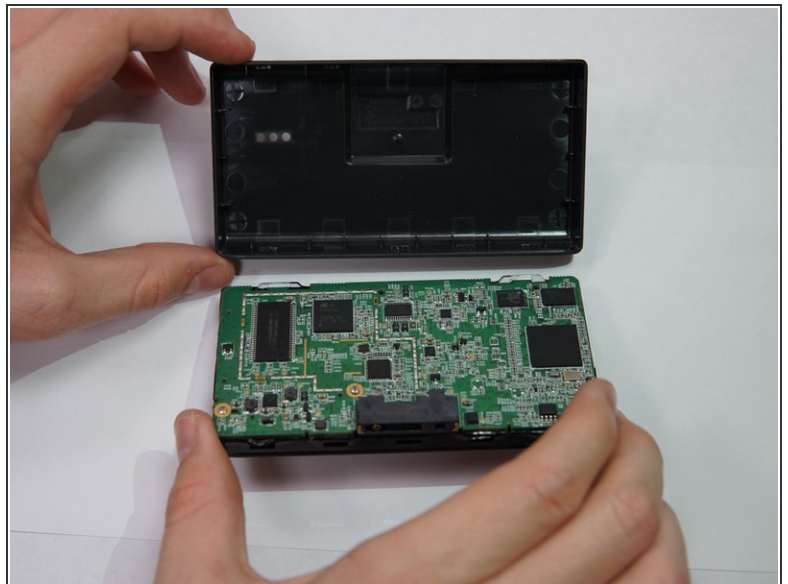
- [iFixit Opening Tools](#) (1)
 - [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)
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Step 1 — Casing



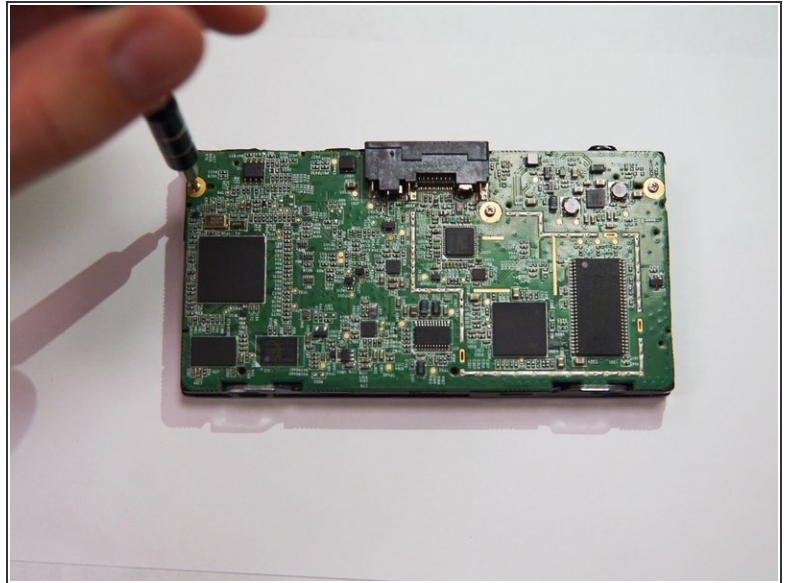
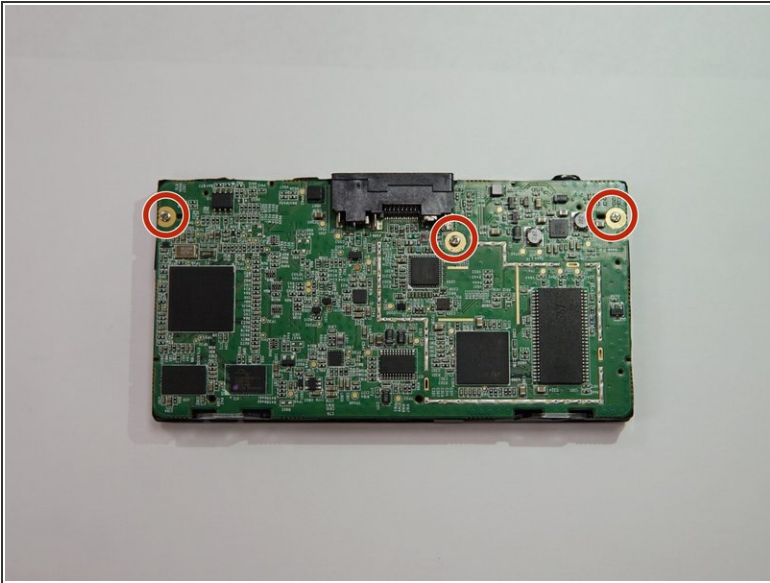
- Take the iFixit opening tool and place it between the back casing and the device as shown.

Step 2



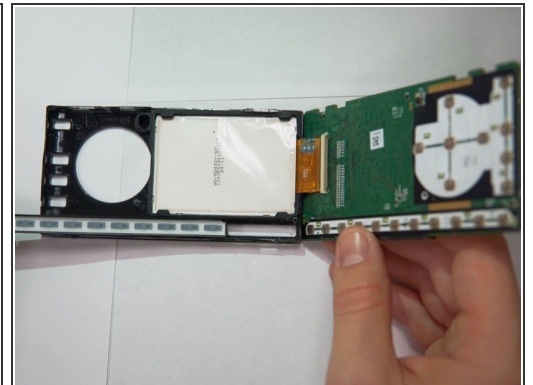
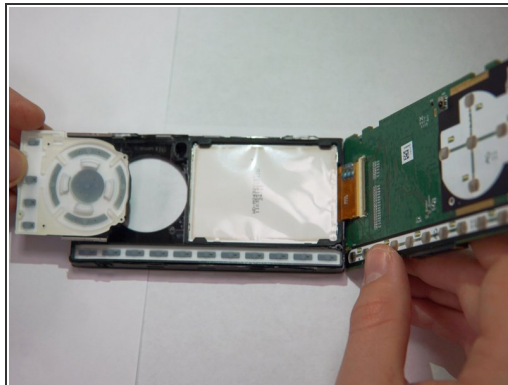
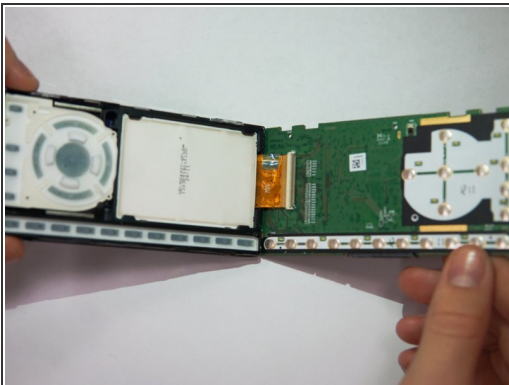
- Apply pressure to the iFixit opening tool, pushing down until the the plastic casing pops off.

Step 3



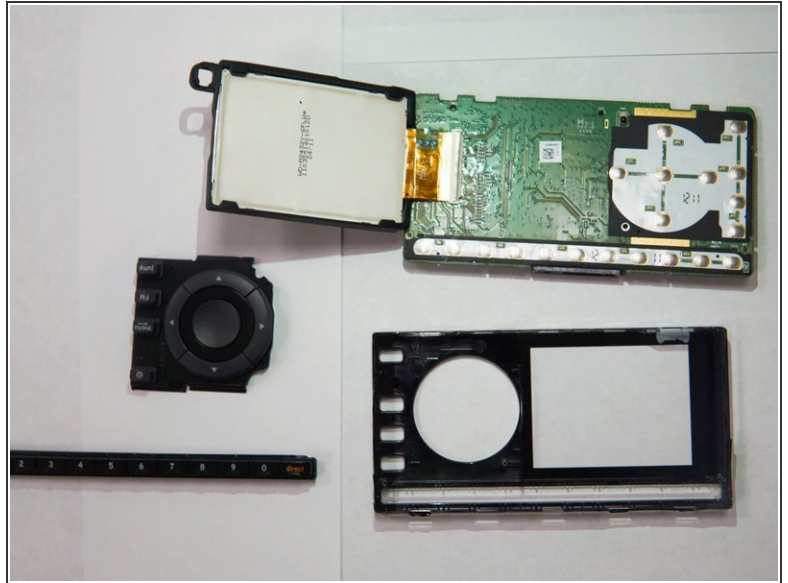
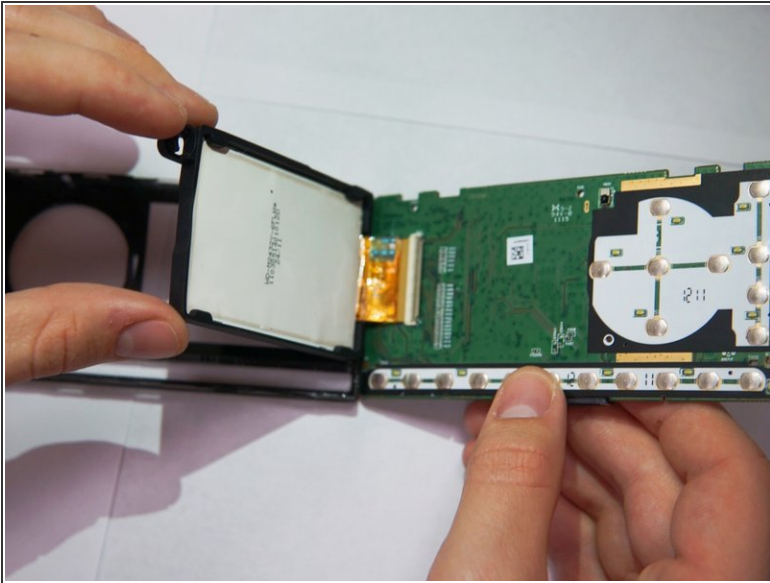
- Use the Phillips PH00 screwdriver to remove the three marked screws.

Step 4



- Remove the buttons from the casing.

Step 5



- Remove the motherboard, and the casing should be free.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
