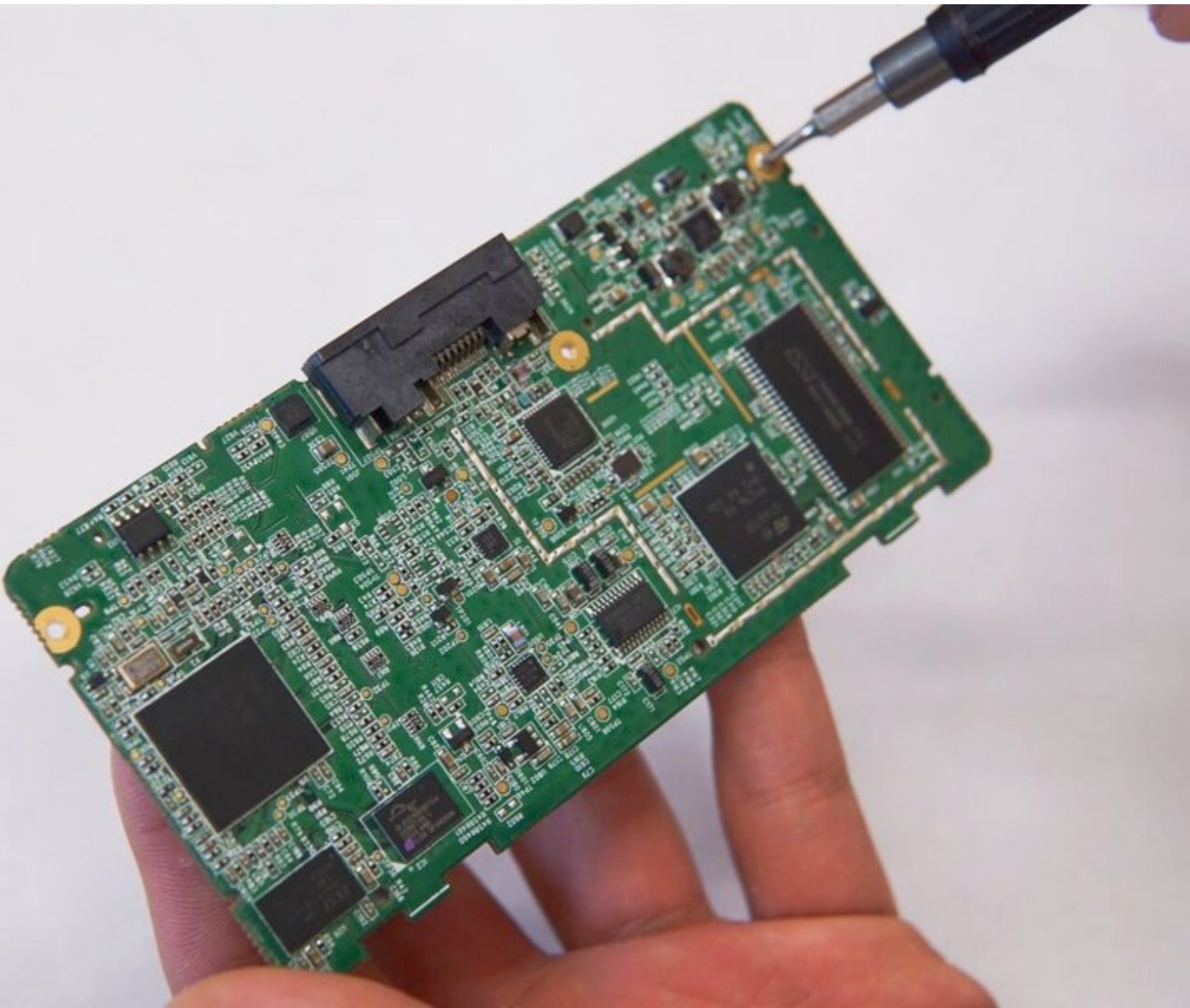




# SiriusXM Onyx Motherboard Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

The motherboard is fixed to the casing by three screws. This guide will show how to open the casing, remove the screws, and detach the motherboard.

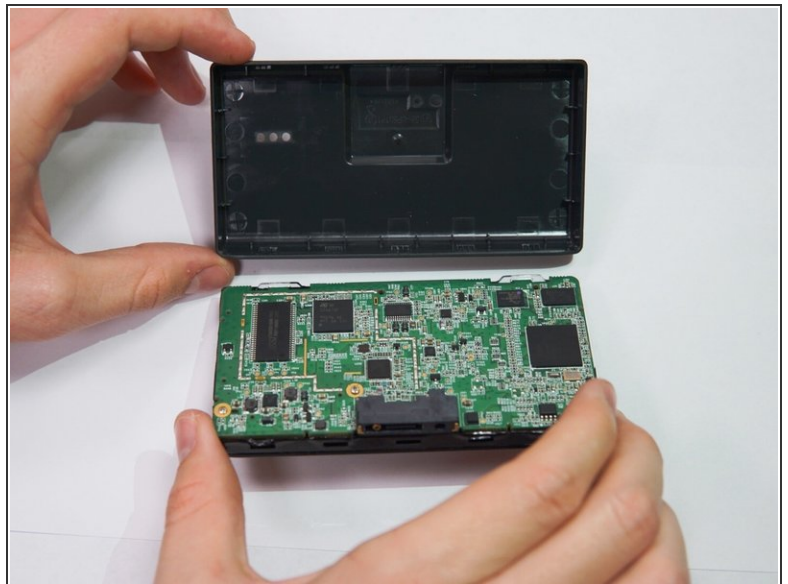
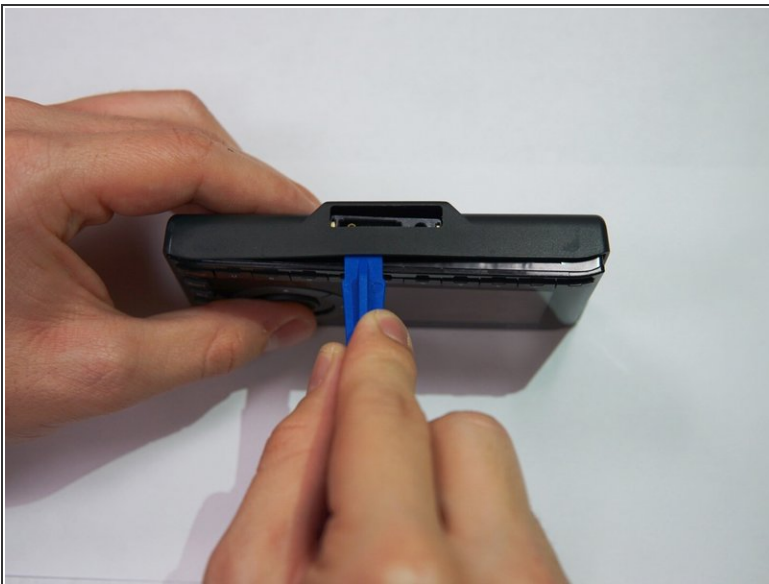

## Step 1 — Motherboard



- Take the iFixit opening tool and place it between the crevice as shown.

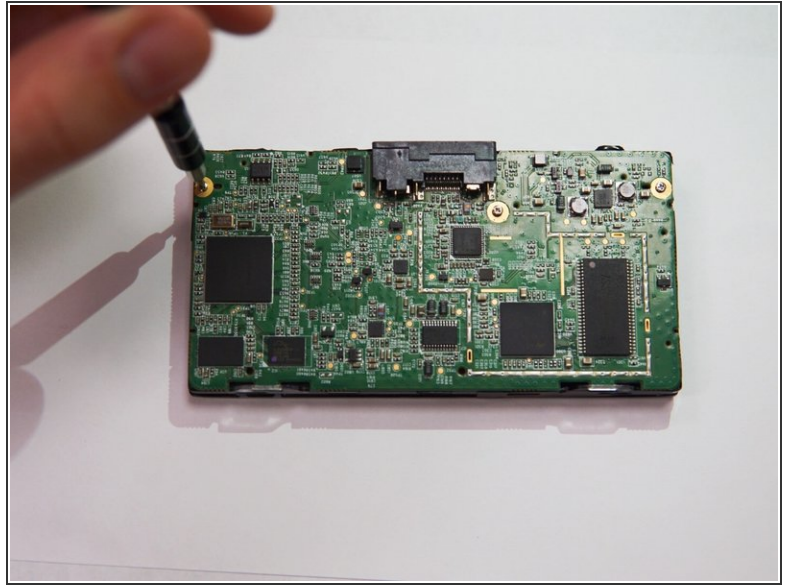
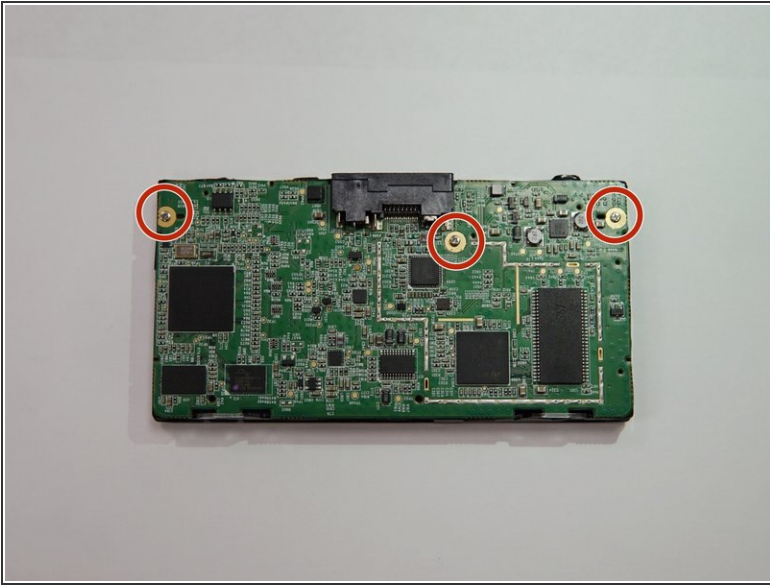
## Step 2



- Apply pressure to the iFixit opening tool, pushing down until the the plastic casing pops off.

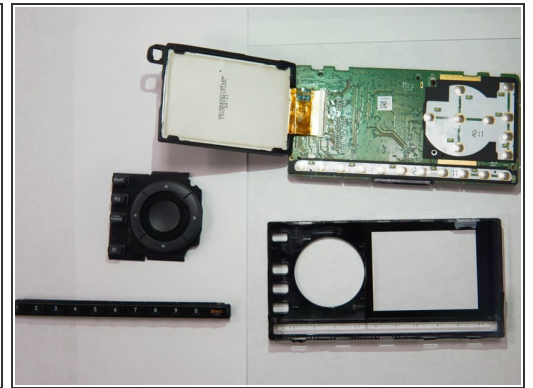
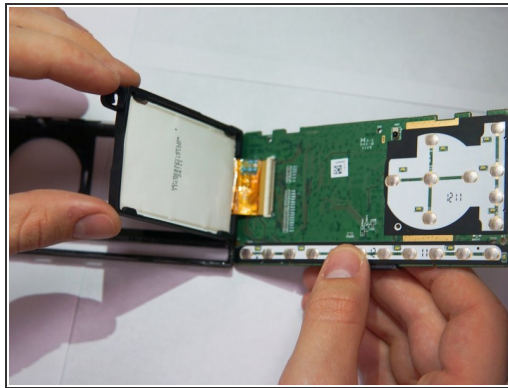
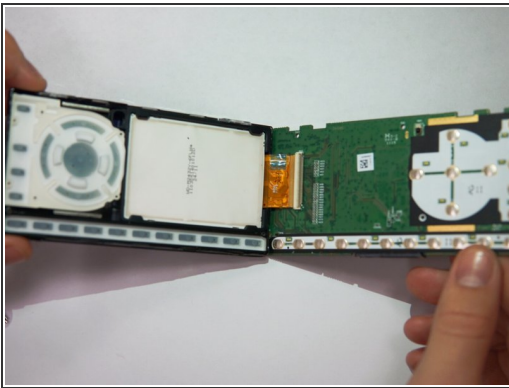


### Step 3



- Use the Phillips PH00 to remove the three marked screws.

### Step 4



- Once the screws have been removed, the motherboard is free to come out.
