



Skateboard Trucks Replacement

How to replace trucks on a skateboard.

INTRODUCTION

Broke your skateboard deck and don't want to buy a complete? Bought new truck? In this guide I will teach you how to replace trucks.

TOOLS:

- 3/8" Drive Ratchet (1)

Step 1 — Trucks



- First you are going to grab your T tool. If you don't have one, buy one, or grab a 3/8" socket and allen or phillips head (depending on the screws on your skateboard).

Step 2



- Then you get your deck and your trucks.

Step 3



- Put the 8 screws in the 8 mounting holes on the deck.

Step 4



- Put the trucks on the bottom of the skateboard on the screws. Then loosely tighten the nuts on the screws.

Step 5



- Put the allen or phillips head on the screw to hold it in place then put the 3/8" socket on the bolt. Tighten the bolts and start riding because you just set up your skateboard

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
