The cable connection on the Sony FS7 can become loose after years of use. As a result, the image to the viewfinder will cut in and out. Let's fix it!

INTRODUCTION

Let's fix your Sony FS7. This method should also be compatible with the Sony FS7 Mark II, and very similar to the Sony FS5.

- You'll also need the following:
- Phillips head screwdriver, one small and one large
- Tweezers
